No.F.3(1)/2018-Cord(1).- In pursuance of section 107 of the Election Act, 2017, read with clause (3) of Article 59 and clause (3) of Article 224 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Election Commission of Pakistan hereby calls upon the Members of the **Provincial Assemblies of the Punjab, Sindh, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Balochistan Province** to elect to the Senate seven Members from general seats, two Members from the seats reserved for women and two Members for the seats reserved for Technocrats including Ulema from each of Province of the Punjab, Sindh, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Balochistan in place of the Members of the Senate, who are due to retire after the expiration of their term of office on 11th March, 2018 and fixes, in relation thereto, the following dates for the nomination of candidates, the scrutiny of nomination papers, filing of appeals, disposal of appeals, withdrawal of candidature and for the taking of the poll at the places noted against them:
