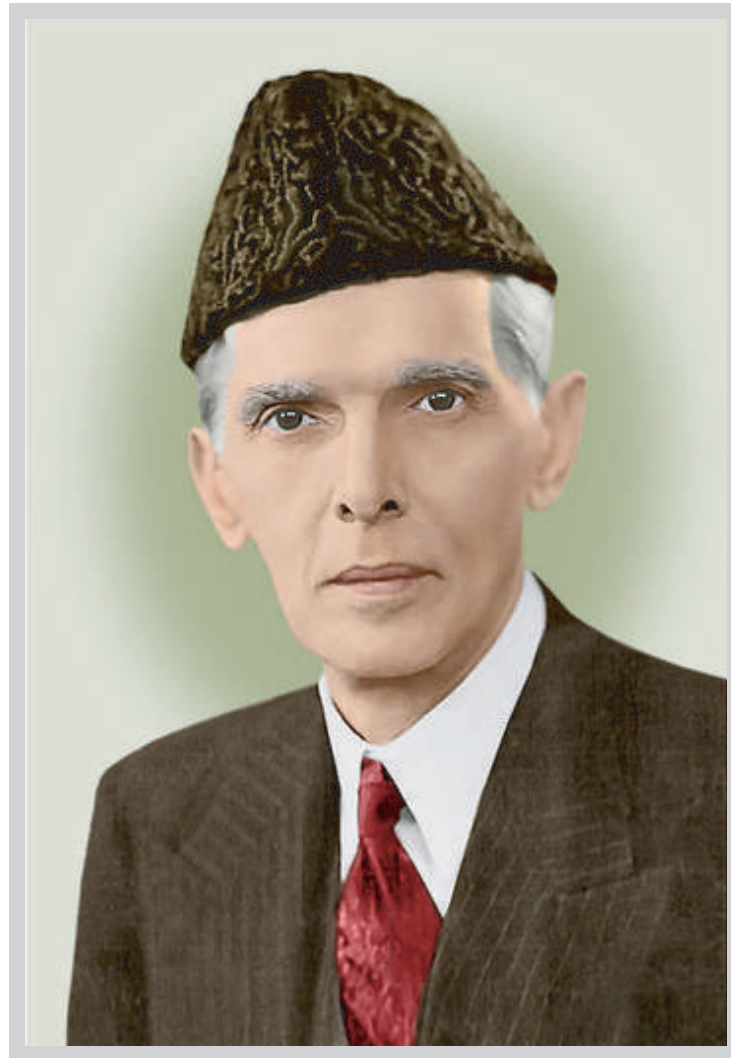

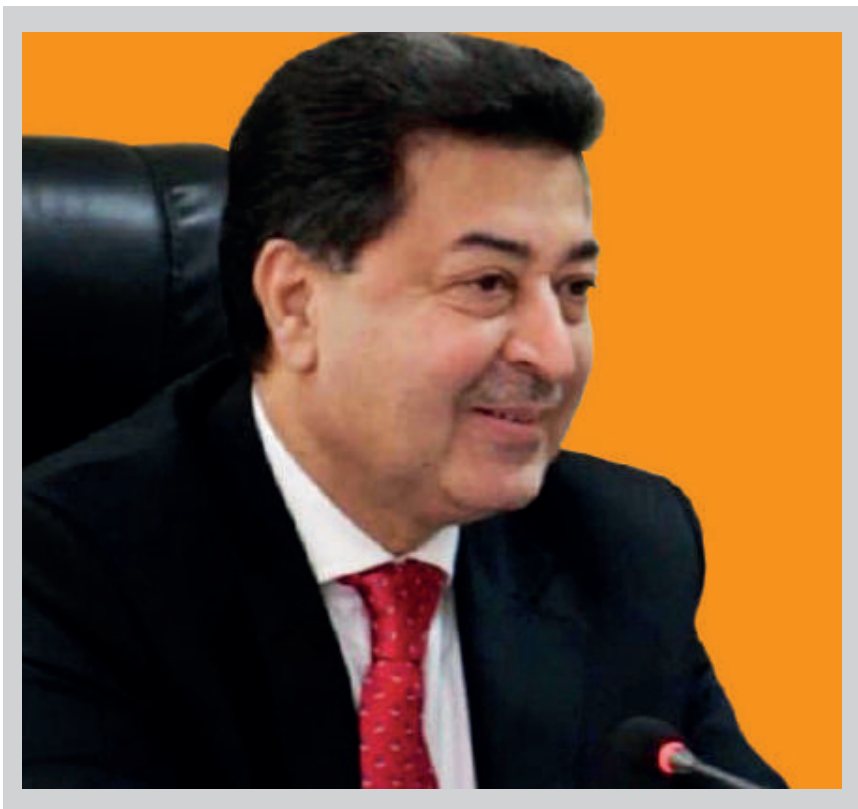

Background

Under section 204 of the Election Act 2017, the honorable ECP aimed to strengthen the monitoring mechanism by placing transparency as a central focus during ongoing reforms. Keeping the challenge of "Annual monitoring of electoral process" (especially with 125 MAs in view), it directed to introduce M & E Wing and to create a robust technology-enabled Monitoring and Evaluation Mechanism to prevent electoral violations, conduct verification and dissemination and to formulate accountability procedures. For the purpose an M & E Management Information System (MIS) called EM was designed and developed to help generate machine evidence on violations and non-compliance in the Election Act 2017, Election Rules 2017 and the provisions, thus improving accountability of election officials and other stakeholders involved in the electoral process, such as contestants, political parties and voters.



The Vision

TRANSPARENCY & ACCOUNTABILITY OF ELECTORAL PROCESSES FOR CREDIBLE ELECTIONS

To monitor the pre-poll, poll day and post-poll activities for transparency, information, a System Requirements Specification (SRS) document and an MIS framework were developed for procurement. Software support system of ECP by monitoring near time reporting of violations in the field by District Monitoring Officers and their teams.

TRANSFORMING VISION INTO REALITY

The Secretary ECP played a pivotal role and took up the vision after joining the office capitalizing on his previous experience of BSP and Economic Affairs Division. He started by evaluating the gap envisioned by the honorable ECP at the level of working as well as the architecture and by reviewing monitoring tools for the monitoring mechanism. He prepared the following road map for the structuring of the Monitoring & Evaluation mechanism in coordination with the Monitoring Wing.

- Development of M&E Framework to cater the requirement of all Electoral Processes (Pre-Electoral, Electoral and Post-Electoral)
- Identification and procurement of required MIS (M&E and Field level)
- Identification and procurement of IT equipment
- Development of M&E MIS of ECP for real time monitoring
- Upgradation of COMS-Robot to improve monitoring and decision support system

EMCC: The Vision

The Robust MIS mechanism required a state-of-the-art facility under one roof to receive real time monitoring reports shared by the District Monitoring Teams and instant retrieval through quarter's concerned. This mechanism also factored in the media reporting and general public comments during different stages of elections. The MIS Team alongwith MCO were to be equipped for instant retrieval. Both the mechanisms were to be facilitated through a project Election Monitoring Control Center (EMCC).

- The EMCC is equipped with the following facilities:
- Digital Wall for viewing real time reports
 - 12 LED Screens to monitor mainstream media coverage of election activities
 - Laptop Computers to run the MIS Management Information System
 - Universal Access Number to receive complaints from general public through telephone
 - Help desk and work station for 16 facilitators for 24/7 instant response during at election activities.

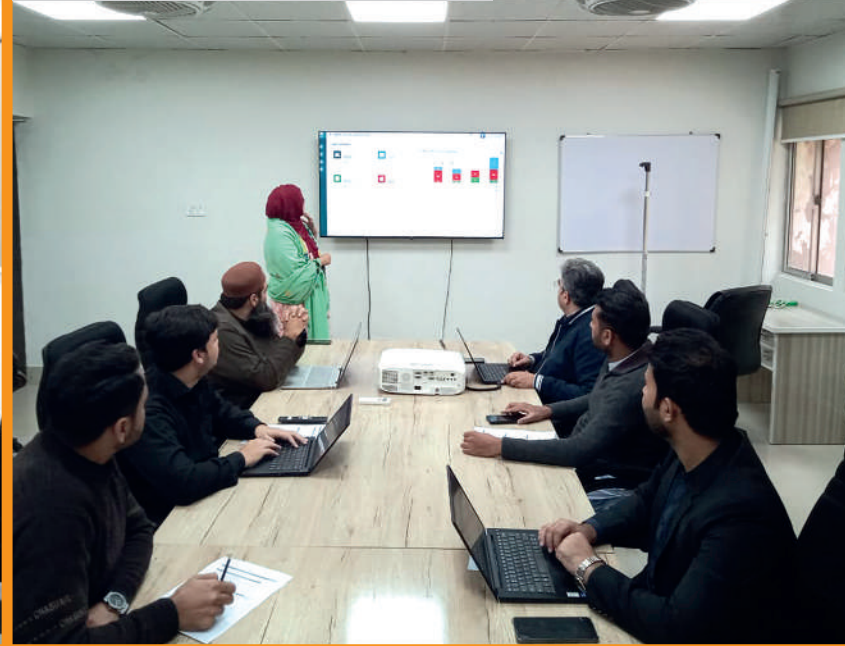
