INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE VOTER

Eligibility Criteria

The Constitution of Pakistan and the Elections Act, 2017 clearly prescribe the following criteria to register as a voter:-

- a) A citizen of Pakistan possesses a National Identity Card issued by the National Database and Registration Authority
- b) Having age not less than 18 years
- c) He is not declared by a competent court to be unsound mind
- d) His vote will be registered in the electoral roll of that electoral area that comes under the address mentioned on his/her NIC i.e. either on permanent or temporary address(as per the choice of the voter)

How to check your voting details

In order to check the voting details, send a SMS on your mobile by writing your CNIC (without dashes) to **8300**

How to register as a new voter

There are two ways to register as a new voter:-

- I. Visit NADRA Office for the issuance of CNIC. Mark the option of either Permanent address or temporary address (where you want to register your vote) mentioned on the CNIC issuance form .Moreover, ensure that the address mentioned on the form is specific i.e House no., street no, and the Electoral Area is properly mentioned in the address.
- II. Visit the office of District Election Commissioner (DEC) concerned and submit Form- 21.(Click here to download Form-21)

How to transfer your vote

There are two ways to transfer your vote:-

 Visit NADRA office and renew or modify your CNIC and ensure that the option to transfer your vote either at temporary or permanent address is marked properly. II. Visit the office of DEC Concerned and submit Form-21 (Click here to download Form-21). You can also submit the same form to the Form Submission Centers at tehsil level. (Click here to check the list of Form Submission Centers).

How to delete/objection on vote.

There are four methods to delete the vote of your closed relatives.

- I. Submit Death Certificate to the office of DEC Concerned along with Form-22(Click here to download Form-22)
- II. Submit Death Certificate to NADRA office
- III. Submit Death Certificate to the Union Council concerned/Cantonment Board
- IV. In case of objection on any entry in the Electoral Rolls of your constituency, submit Form-22 (Click here to download Form-22) to the office of the DEC concerned.

How to correct the particulars of your vote

- I. Visit NADRA office and update your particulars on CNIC
- II. Submit Form-23 to the DEC office Concerned in case of any change in the Name, Father/Husband Name, and House No. (Click here to download Form-23)

Note: The term of the National and provincial Assemblies is going to be completed on 12 August 2023. Therefore the cut-off date was 13-07-2023 which has been extended till 20-7-2023. Hence, any change in the vote can be made only before 20-07-2023(In case of any change, visit main page)
