

Wherever in the world there are strong democracies, there are also strong local government systems. The local government system is considered a primary unit or nursery of democracy. Unfortunately, the past of the local government system in Pakistan has never been something to be proud of. But, contrary to the past the current Election Commission of Pakistan has changed this norm. Over the last three years, the painstaking efforts of ECP have ensured the constitute of local governments countrywide. In this prolonged pathway, numerous obstacles were encountered with perseverance and determination to attain this goal. Besides harsh conditions and vulnerable security measures, LG elections were conducted successfully with sheer determination.

All the phases of local government elections have been completed successfully in the provinces of Sindh, KP and Balochistan, and similarly, for Punjab local government elections, the most difficult task of delimitation has also been completed, and now the process of registration of electoral groups in underway. In the same way, all the stages of delimitation for the conduct of local government elections in the Federal Capital Islamabad have also been completed and the election schedule will be announced at the appropriate time.

The Commission has also initiated the ECP Youth Engagement Policy since November 2021 to engage and educate youth about the significance of their vote. The said program focuses on new voters' education and registration, having conducted 1640+ sessions in educational institutions countrywide.

I am grateful to all my team members who supported me in collecting data, proofreading, and designing, and special thanks to the Worthy Secretary ECP Mr. Omar Hamid Khan under whose dynamic leadership we are continuously publishing the 6th edition of the ECP newsletter since 2022.

Consultative Session with the Political Parties on the upcoming General Elections

Consultative session with Tehreek-e-Insaf & JUI



The first meeting of the Election Commission was held on 24th August, 2023 to consult with the political parties regarding the election's roadmap. The meeting was chaired by the Honorable Chief Election Commissioner, Sikandar Sultan Raja, and was attended by esteemed members of the Election Commission, the Secretary Election Commission, and other senior officers.

The delegation from Tehreek-e-Insaf emphasized the need

to adhere to the constitution's mandate for holding elections within 90 days. They also expressed that currently, there is no requirement for the delimitation of constituencies. They also called for the immediate release of various party leaders and workers who had been arrested. They stressed on the party's right to organize political rallies and demanded equal opportunities in the political arena, on par with other political parties.



The delegation of Jamiat Ulama Islam (F) took a stand that there is no doubt that the holding of elections is a requirement of the constitution, but now that the results of the census have been officially published. Therefore, the Election Commission should first complete the process of delimitation of constituen-

cies so that all political parties, candidates and voters can be facilitated in the upcoming elections. The delegation further said that according to the new census, the correct registration of the voters in the electoral rolls needs to be ensured by the Election Commission before the election.



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Consultative session with PML (N)



The Election Commission invited the Pakistan Muslim League (N) on 25th August, 2023 for the consultation process with the political parties. This advisory meeting was presided over by Mr. Sikandar Sultan Raja, Chief Election Commissioner. In addition to the honorable members of the Election Commissioner.

Third consultative meeting of the Election Commission was held with the delegation of MQM Pakistan at 11 AM and with the delegation of Jamaat-e-Islami at 12 noon on 28th August, 2023. The meeting was presided over by Mr. Sikandar Sul-

tan Raja, Chief Election Commissioner. Honorable members of Election Commission, Secretary and other senior officers attended.



The Jamaat-e-Islami delegation said that the Election Commission should have started this consultation process earlier. According to the constitution, after the dissolution of the assemblies, the process of elections should be completed within 90 days. In order to remove the ambiguity, Election Commis-

sion should have announced the Election Schedule as well along with initiation of process of Delimitation. The Election Commission is empowered with authority thus it should fulfill its responsibilities according to the constitution and law.

Consultative session with PPPP

Election Commission of Pakistan held another consultstive meeting with Pakistan Peoples Party (Parliamentarian) delegation on 29-08-2023. Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner Mr. Sikandar Sultan Rana chaired the meeting. The Members Election Commission, Secretary ECP and other senior officers

also attended the meeting. On the other hand, Mr. Nayyar Bukhari, Ms. Sherry Rehman, Mr. Murad Ali Shah, Mr. Naveed Qamar, Mr. Taj Haider and Mr. Faisal Karim Kundi attended the meeting from Pakistan Peoples Party side.

Consultative session with ANP, BAP, and BNP



The Election Commission of Pakistan held three consultative meetings on 30th August, 2023 with various political parties. The first meeting involved a delegation from the Awami National Party (ANP), followed by the Balochistan Awami Party (BAP), and finally the Balochistan National Party (BNP) at the ECP Secretariat in Islamabad.

These sessions were scheduled at 11 AM, 2 PM, and 3 PM respectively. The meetings were chaired by the Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner, Mr. Sikandar Sultan Raja. Members of the Election Commission, Secretary ECP and other senior officers also attended the meetings.



Representatives from the Awami National Party, Mr. Mian iftikhar Hussain, Mr. Zahid Khan, Mr. Khushdil Khan, and Mr. Abdul Rahim Wazir attended the meeting. The Balochistan Awami Party was represented by Mr. Nasibullah, Mr. Manzoor

Kakar, Mr. Noor Muhammad Dummar, and Sardar Abdul Rahman Khetran. Balochistan National Party's representation included Mr. Abdul Kareem Nosherwani, Ms. Sana Jamali, and Mr. Danish Kumar.





The delegation from the Balochistan Awami Party endorsed the Election Commission's new delimitation decisions. BAP members stated that since the census results have been published, there is no need to carry out new delimitation, as it could lead to discrepancies with political parties, candidates, and the public. They recommended that a fair and transparent delimitation and unbiased elections be ensured.

Furthermore, they emphasized that before announcing the

election schedule following delimitation, the seasonal effects in different parts of the country should be considered, so that candidates and voters do not face difficulties during the elections. They praised the Chief Election Commissioner and the Election Commission's performance, expressing their complete trust in their abilities. The Balochistan Awami Party expressed complete confidence in the Election Commission, based on past decisions as well.

Consultative session with TLP and PML (Q)



The Election Commission held 6th consultative meetings on 31st August, 2023 with two major political parties. The first meeting was with Tehreek-e-Labbaik Pakistan and the second meeting with Pakistan Muslim League (Q) delegation, at 11:30 AM and 2:00 PM respectively. The meetings were chaired by Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner Mr. Sikandar Sultan Raja, Members of the Election Commission, Secretary ECP

and other senior officers also attended the meeting. From Tehreek-e-Labbaik Pakistan, Chaudhry Rizwan, Muhammad Qasim, Zia ur Rahman, and Chaudhry Azhar attended the meeting. Meanwhile, from Pakistan Muslim League (Q), Muhammad Tariq Hussain, Ms. Farukh Khan, Ghulam Mustafa, Rizwan Sadiq, and Hafiz Aqeel Jalil were present.



The Pakistan Muslim League (Q) delegation endorsed the Election Commission's decision on the new constituency delimitation. They emphasized that a new delimitation was necessary based on the released census results to ensure fairness.

Both parties expressed confidence in the Election Commission's capabilities and commitment to transparent elections. The Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner assured that the ongoing schedule for delimitation are supposed to be completed within 120 days by December 14, 2023 however ECP

is trying to squeeze the duration of process and after that would immediately announce election schedule. The Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner also reiterated the Commis-

sion's dedication to transparent and lawful constituency delimitations and elections.

Consultative session with GDA



The Election Commission held a consultative meeting with a delegation of Grand Democratic Alliance (GDA) on 1st September, 2023. The meeting was chaired by Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner Sikandar Sultan Raja. Members Election Commission, Secretary ECP and other senior officers also attended the meeting.

From the Grand Democratic Alliance (GDA), Ms. Fehmida Marza, Dr. Safdar Ali Abbasi, Mr. Kashif Nazamani, and Mr. Ibn Muhammad participated, while Mr. Sardar Abdul Rahim

and Mr. Irfanullah Khan Marwat attended the meeting via video link

The Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner informed the delegation that the Election Commission has called an important meeting today with other political parties, taking consultations and their feedback into account, the Election Commission will announce the election schedule after further reducing the duration of the delimitation process.


EMCC Unveiled: Election Commission Briefs Media







Delimitation of Constituencies




Special initiatives in Development & Infrastructure


