REPRESENTATION U/S 21(3) OF THE ELECTION ACT, 2017 AGAINST THE PRELIMINARY DELIMITATION OF THE CONTITUENCY IN RESPECT OF NA-250 (PS-120) AND NA-251 PS-119) NOTIFIED ON 05.03.2018

Respected Sir,

With reference to notification No. F.8(3)/2018-Elec-I dated 05.03.2018, regarding publication of preliminary report of delimitation of constituencies of National Assemblies and Provincial Assemblies, we hereby filed objections against the above said preliminary delimitation of national and provincial constituencies NA-250 (PS-120) AND NA-251 (PS-119) as under:

- i. That the principles laid down in section 20 of the Election Act, 2017 and rule 12 of the Election Rules, 2017 have not been complied with in stricto-senso.
- ii. That geographically compact area cannot be construed only to the thickly populated area but it has vast meaning which includes cultural values, norms and tribal distribution as well. Since in Karachi City is the largest city of the country comprising on different communities and tribes. They were living together since the creation of Pakistan amicably but unfortunately some foreign agencies created/promoted these distributions which caused violence in the city and now one of

the neighbourer has great hatred with his neighbourer who belongs to other community. Unfortunately the preliminary delimitation which has been made without considering the above facts which is most important factor to keep peace, harmony and brotherhood among the residents of constituencies. Some of the areas are called Pakhtun Belt and some are called MQM Belt, who cannot bear each other. Though after successful operation launched by the LEAs/IAs in Karachi, law and order situation has become satisfactory but it is not a permanent solution and if the preliminary delimitation remains intact, there are more possibilities that the previous group in order to dominate will again become active. In order to curb all the above factors, it would be appropriate that proposed amendments in the delimitation may kindly be approved.

- iii. That the next principle of delimitation is physical feature which is also correlated with the first one.
- iv. That the industrial area i.e. Site Area consists of labourers who belongs to different provinces of the country and residing nearest their working places i.e. Mills/Factories. Contrary to this the other communities who are residing on the other side of the Railway track/road have different set of minds, they may be businessmen, government servants or affiliated with any other profession so there is hell of difference between such communities.

- v. That most important fact which determines all other factors is facility of communication and public convenience. In the instant case public road transport facilities between the proposed delimitation are much better than the preliminary delimitation. Resultantly all the inhabitants shall suffer an irreparable loss on account of education and health if the preliminary delimitation kept intact. On this score alone, the demand of petitioner is prima facie and merits consideration.
- vi. So far as cognate factor is concerned, naturally the people have relations with the people where they feel convenient and have communication facilities. Accordingly the justification given in sub-para (i) above, is sufficient to clear the ground realities of the above constituencies and there is no need to further elaborate cognate factor.
- vii. That the rule of northern end has also been violated in all the constituencies, which is against the natural justice. All the laws are made for the welfare/facilitation of general public and not to bother the public.
- viii. Apart from above, it has also been laid down in section 20(4) of the Election Act, 2017 that if the limit of 10% is exceeded in any case, the commission can do so after recording the reasons. The condition is last one in the above section meaning thereby that the Authors of the law were much conscious about the priorities of the legislation, first they have given the basic principles which are primary conditions and then the later one was given place

in the section. If the primary conditions are fulfilled, the later one can be relaxed by, the Honourable Commission. Needless to say that relaxation in this sub-section has been extended to an urban area of Punjab province which is a developed city whereas Karachi has different communities, tribes and the most alarming is sectarian violence, therefore, Karachi deserves for this relaxation more than that city. All the pre-requisites of the concerned section read with relevant rule have been complied with in the proposed delimitation of above said national and provincial constituencies of Karachi District.

It is worthwhile to mention here that the population of Karachi ix. district has not been so increased due to which a new constituency was required to be delimited and only minor changes were required but unfortunately the delimitation of 3 NA's constituencies has been disturbed. Contrary to this in other districts where there is minor changes involved, only one patwar circle or two have been excluded/included from that constituency. The example of District Chakwal is very important and in this way Article 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 has been violated. There are many other examples in the proposed notification of delimitation, where the previous delimitation was kept intact with slightly amendments, accordingly the petitioners have to be treated at par. All the citizens of Pakistan are entitled for equal treatment but this principle has not been adhered to while delimiting the constituencies of Karachi West District.
