That undersigned is Senior Vice President of Sindh United Party and candidate at one of the above mentioned constituencies being aggrieved and dissatisfied with the notification passed on 05-03-2018 by Additional Secretary (Admn/Election) filed objections before Commission may be pleased make such amendments or modify in final list.

1. That the periodic delimitation of electoral constituencies redistribution, is necessary in any representative system. If electoral constituencies boundaries are not periodically adjusted population inequities develop across district.
  2. That the district Shaheed Benazirabad consist of four Talukas from North to South i-e Taluka (1) Daur (2) Nawabshah (3) Sakrand (4) Kazi Ahmed with eight STC's i-e (i) Daur (ii) Jam Sahib (iii) Nawabshah (iv) Sakrand (v) Gohram Mari (vi) Kazi Ahmed (vii) Daulat pur (viii) Sawri respectively.
  3. That as per Census 2017, District Shaheed Benazirabad has following population Taluka wise.

**GROUND FOR PROPOSAL COMPOSITION OF NA-213 SHAHEED  
BENAIZIRABAD-I**

- That after including TC Marri Sabbar of STC Jam sahib in NA-213, Taluka Daur is more convenient to the people of the area as it is well connected to NA-213 instead of notified composition i-e NA-214.
- That is pertinent to mention here that TC Marri Sabbar is part of STC Jam Sahib and it is unnecessary to break of STC Jam Sahib because it is violation of principles of delimitation. As which cause no effect on population criteria as well as other ingredients of delimitation of constituency so it (Marri Sabbar TC) may be included in NA-213.
- That the main connecting highway is N-5 which passes through center of both talukas Sakrand & Kazi Ahmed. TC Marri Sabbar is far from this highway and has no direct linkage from Talukas and constituency area. TC is part of and well connected to Taluka Daur. So communication approach of the people may be given due consideration. (Map is annexed for ready reference).

4. That TC Marri Sabbar is part of Union Council Mirza Farukh Baig of taluka Daur along with two more dehs i-e Kaleri and Jhemal. It is Further submitted that Union Council is devided into two geographical areas one in NA-213 and other in NA-214.
