REPRESENTATION AGAINST DELIMITATION OF CONSTITUENCIES OF DISTRICT KHUSHAB PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE ELECTIONS ACT, 2017

It is most respectfully submitted: -

1 That the Applicants No. 1 to 3 have filed the instant representation in representative capacity on behalf of all the residents of Chak No. 21 MB (Population: 520), Chak No. 22 MB (Population: 1961), Chak No. 23 MB (Population: 2618), Chak No. 24 MB (Population: 1648), Chak No. 25 MB (Population: 1161), Chak No. 26 MB (Population: 1923), Chak No. 27 MB (Population: 1494), Chak No. 28 MB (Population: 1119), Chak No. 30 MB (Population: 1324), Chak No. 31 MB (Population: 1492), Chak No. 32 MB (Population: 959) in district Khushab (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Chaks"). Furthermore, Applicants No. 4 & 5 are representing residents of "Bijar Janubi (Population:



10,105)", "Sheikhu (Population: 1698)" and "Bijar Shumali (Population: 113").

- That according to preliminary delimitation of constituencies of district Khushab the "Chaks" have been included in PP 84
 Khushab-III and NA 93. On the other hand "Bijar Janubi", Khushab-III and "Bijar Shumali" have been included into PP "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" have been included into PP 82 Khushab-I and NA 94.
 - 3. That the inclusion of "Chaks" into PP-84 Khushab-III/NA 93 and inclusion of villages "Bijar Janubi", "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" into PP 82 Khushab-I/NA 94 blatantly violates the principles of delimitation of Constituencies enumerated in section 20 of the Elections Act, 2017, Election Rules, 2017 and guidelines of this Hon'ble Commission.
 - 4. The Applicants No. 1 to 3 request exclusion of the "Chaks" from PP 84 Khushab-III/NA 93 and their inclusion into PP 82 Khushab-I/ NA 94. Whereas Applicants No. 4 & 5 request exclusion of villages "Bijar Janubi", "Sheikhu" and "Bijar exclusion of villages "Bijar Janubi", "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" from PP 82 Khushab-I/NA 94 and their inclusion into PP 84 Khushab-III/NA 93 on following grounds:

GROUNDS

A. That in accordance with section 20 of the Elections Act, 2017 all constituencies for general seats shall, as far as practicable, be delimited having regard to the distribution of population in geographically compact areas, physical

features, existing boundaries of administrative units, facilities of communication and public convenience and other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity in the creation of constituencies.

- B. That a plain and simple look at the map of district Khushab (appended with the instant representation makes it crystal clear that the "Chaks" are geographically contiguous to PP 82 Khushab- I and NA 94. In fact, the "Chaks" are completely surrounded by PP 82 Khushab-I and NA 94 from all directions.
 - C. That the western boundary of the "Chaks" is contiguous to PP 82 Khushab- I and NA 94 stretching to approximately 25 km. To the East again an approximate boundary of 25 Km is shared with PP 82 Khushab-I and NA 94. Whereas, southern boundary with PP 82 Khushab-I and NA 94 is approximately 10 Km long. To the North a boundary of approximately 10 Km is shared with PP 84 Khushab-III and NA 93. Therefore, in order to preserve geographical compactness, it is necessary that the "Chaks" are included into PP 82 Khushab-I and NA 94.
 - D. As apparent from a brief examination of the attached map of district Khushab constituencies, the distance between "Chaks" and MC Mitha Tiwana in PP 82 Khushab-I and NA 94 is approximately 15 Km on a metalled road. Similarly, towards west distance between "Chaks & Rakh Peelovains" from Union headquarter Adhikot in PP 82

Metalled road. However, there is no straight metalled road connecting Tehsil headquarter Quaidabad in PP 84

Khushab-III/ NA 93 and the "Chaks". It is noteworthy that to reach tehsil headquarter Quaidabad in PP 84 Khushab

III/NA 93, the residents of the "Chaks" have to first travel to MC Mith Tiwana or Union Council AdhiKot in PP 82

Khushab-I/NA 94 covering a distance of almost 50 km in both directions.

- E. Therefore, all essential facilities of life including hospitals, schools and colleges located within PP 82 Khushab –I/NA 94 are easily accessible to residents of the "Chaks". Hence, in view of overwhelming public convenience and facilities of communication, it is imperative that the "Chaks" are included into PP 82 Khushab-I/NA 94.
 - F. Furthermore, a plain and simple reading of the map of district Khushab appended with the instant representation makes it abundantly clear that villages "Bijar Janubi", "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" are situated very close at a distance of approximately 10 km from Tehsil headquarter Quaidabad of PP 84 Khushab-III/NA 93. On the other hand distance between villages "Bijar Janubi", "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" and Tehsil headquarter Noorpur Thal of PP 82 Khushab-I/NA 94 is approximately 60 km.
 - G. Furthermore, It can be seen from the map that villages "Bijar Janubi", "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" are

situated near along main Sargodha-Mianwali highway going towards tehsil headquarter Quaidabad of PP 84 Khushab-III/NA 93. However, there is no direct metalled road from aforesaid three villages leading to tehsil headquarter Noorpur thal of PP 82 Khushab-I/NA 94.

- H. Therefore, all fundamental facilities of life including hospitals, schools and colleges are located within PP 84

 Khushab —III/NA 93 at a very short distance of 10 km approximately in tehsil headquarter Quaidabad. Hence, in view of overwhelming public convenience and facilities of communication, it is imperative that the three villages are included back into PP 84 Khushab-III/NA 93.
 - "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" are concerned, they are characterized by rich fertile land similar to most areas of PP 84 Khushab-III as opposed to PP 82 Khushab-I/NA 94, which is characterized by desert Thal. Thus, there is a huge disparity between civilization, culture and traditions of the aforesaid three subject Villages and PP 82 Khushab-I/NA 94. Moreover, the residents of villages "Bijar Janubi", "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" have strong social ties/bonds with tehsil quaidabad in PP 84 Khushab III/NA 93.
 - J. That after inclusion of "Chaks" into PP 82 Khushab- I/NA

and "Bijar Shumali" from PP 82 Khushab I/NA 94, the total constituency population of PP 82 Khushab I/NA 94 shall become 431,872/- and 627,586/-. On the other hand after exclusion of "Chaks" from PP 84 Khushab-III/NA 93 and after inclusion of villages "Bijar Janubi", "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" into PP 84 Khushab-III/NA 93, the total constituency population of PP 84 Khushab-III/NA 93, the would become 421,578/- and 653,713/-. Therefore the variation in population of all constituencies involved shall remain less than 10 %.

PRAYER

In view of the above, it is most respectfully prayed that upon acceptance of this representation, this Hon'ble Commission may:-

a. Alter and modify Constituencies PP 84 Khushab-III/NA
93 and PP 82 Khushab-I/NA 94 of district Khushab by
excluding all the "chaks" mentioned in Para 1 above
from PP 84 Khushab-III/ NA 93 and incorporating them
into PP 82 Khushab-I/NA 94. Similarly, villages "Bijar
Janubi", "Sheikhu" and "Bijar Shumali" may graciously

be included back into PP 84 Khushab III/NA 93 by excluding them from PP 82 Khushab I/NA 94 through issuance of final list of the Constituencies in the interest of justice and public interest.
