REPRESENTATION/OBJECTION ON DELIMITATION OF PB-22 KILLA ABDULLAH-II & PB-23 KILLA ABDULLAH-II, BALOCHISTAN

Respected Sir,

With reference to Notification No. F.8(3)/2018-Elec-I dated 05.03.2018, regarding publication of preliminary report of delimitation of constituencies of National Assemblies and Provincial Assemblies, we hereby filed objections against the above said preliminary delimitation of National and Provincial constituencies PB-22 KILLA ABDULLAH-I & PB-23 KILLA ABDULLAH-II as under:

- i. That the principles laid down in section 20 of the Election Act, 2017 and rule 12 of the Election Rules, 2017 have not been complied with while delimiting PB-22 KILLA ABDULLAH-I & PB-23 KILLA ABDULLAH-II.
- ii. That there is no PC in Killa Abdullah Tehsil. Similarly there is no Patwar Circle of Gulistan Tehsil. Thus the picture which has been placed before the Honourable Commission while making delimitation is not correct. Copies of notification of Revenue Department are enclosed herewith.
- iii. That PC Gulistan has been shown in Tehsil Gulistan, whereas PC Gulistan has also been shown in Killa Abdullah, which is also contrary to the facts and documents of Revenue Department. Maps issued by the Revenue Department are enclosed herewith.
- iv. While delimiting the above two constituencies, the principles of section 20 of the Act have totally been violated. The PB-23 starts from one side of the province touching Afghanistan and ended on the boundary of other side of province, which also leads to other end of Afghanistan towards Iran.
- v. That there is tribal rivalry between the Hamidzai, Masayzai Kakar and Ghabayzai clans since 1990 and hundreds of people have been murdered from both the sides. These tribes are residing together and in the preliminary delimitation of PB-22 & PB-23, all have been equally distributed among these constituencies, as a result there will be clash during the election process and it



is impossible to conduct the elections in the preliminary delimited constituencies. Thus the geographical, cognate and public convenience factors do not appear there. Hence, the proposed compactness delimitation is much better than the preliminary one.

vi. That so far as concerned, the facility of communication which is also one of the ingredient of section 20, it is important to mention here that how it is possible for a voter to approach his representative in the other side of the province, similarly it is also impossible for the MPA to look after the affairs of the other side of the constituency after travelling near about one thousand Kilometers. Similarly the distance from Quetta to Dobandi is near about 1000 KM. According to general description of district Killa Abdullah, the District spread over from 1500-2700 meters above sea level and has 153 KM of nettled roads and 1020 kilometers of shingle roads. Thus with this communication facilities how it is possible for a voter to reach his representative and vice versa. So the communication and convenience both have been overlooked by the delimiting committees. PC Jalga of Tehsil Dobandi is situated far from Gulistan and there is no communication facilities to reach Gulistan.

vii. That Gulistan PC has been shown in Killa Abdullah comprising Regi and Ro Abdul Rahman Zai Mouza's, which is not correct. In fact, these mouza's are part of Killa Abdullah PC. Therefore, the position is not correct as has been mentioned. Copies of revenue notifications/maps have also been enclosed.

viii. That the rule of Northern end has also been overlooked by the concerned committees and if the said principle was applied even then the delimitation would be the same as are being proposed.

ix. If any principle of above section of Act or the rule referred to above was taken into consideration, the delimitation would be as under:-
