SUBJECT REPRESENTATION CUM OBJECTIONS IN TERMS OF SECTION 21 OF THE ELECTIONS ACT, 2017 R/W RULE 12 OF ELECTION RULES, 2017 FURTHER R/W ARTICLE 218 (3) OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN 1973.

The applicant most respectfully submits as under:-

- 1. That the applicant is a registered voter of Mouza Inayatullah Karez, Tehsil Gulistan, District Killa Abdullah now part of PB-23 Killa Abdullah and NA-264, having Shumariyat Block Code No.454040109, Silsila No.7, as such, interested in democratic norms, election in the country, particularly in the delimitation of his own constituency, hence has a right to make representation and raise a voice against incorrect delimitation process.
- 2. That the above constituency is part of Balochistan which is the largest province in measurement but smallest in population, the area of this part of country is 347190 Square Kilometer while the population is 12344739, to the National Assembly sixteen general seats have been allocated for Balochistan in the forthcoming elections, whereas three are

meant for women. Similarly in the Provincial Assembly fifty one seats of Provincial Assembly's candidates are to be elected directly while eleven and three seats have been reserved to women and the minorities respectively.

3. That the constituencies of National Assembly in Balochistan are based on some data which has recently been notified by this Commission, detail whereof is given below:-





5. That reason to reproduce the details of para No.3 & 4 in this representation is to highlight many things unratural, i.e. areas, population etc of some constituencies in




the Province which are apparent on the face of record, as such can be noticed with a naked eye even without arguments.


- 6. That this commission in preliminary delimitation suggested the constituency as PB-23 wherein certain areas/Patwar circles have been removed and added in PB-22, but they have no nexus with the population, tribes and areas of PB-22 on the basis of population, ground realities and geographical boundaries, besides tribes of these areas are also in conflict with the people of areas of PB-22.
- 7. That in the circumstances, the petitioner being a registered voter of NA/ PB in question i.e. NA-264 & PB-23 Killa Abdullah is aggrieved/ interested to correct the wrong made in preliminary delimitation to file this representation cum objection on the following amongst other grounds:-

GROUNDS

- A. That till now the final census report has not been published, as such, the whole exercise appears to be premature.
- B. That there are no similarities while making the constituencies in respect of areas and population, hence on this count too it is bad.



- C. That the maps of the constituencies prepared by this Commission have been supplied late, besides these are incorrect and do not tally with the maps of Survey department even it is not in consonance of Goggle maps, hence the commission may look into.
- D. That the criteria meant in the Election Act,
 2017 and the rules have been ignored resulting miscarriage of justice.
- E. That there is no economic, cultural, cognitive and social relationship between the areas which have been added in PB-22 and removed from the constituency aloud.
- F. That the areas of Patwar circles Aghbarg and Farakhi have been removed from PB-23 and added in PB-22, but they have no nexus, with the areas of PB-22 on the basis of population, ground realities and geographical boundaries, besides tribes of these areas are also in severe conflict/enmity with each other and in the enmity

hundreds of people are died from the last approx fourty years.

- G. That due to tribal rivalries, one cannot move freely in the area, when a tribal notable moves in the constituency, he will arrange special security, hence restoration of previous position of the constituency will help this Commission to conduct free and fair elections.
- H. That furthermore, the population of the constituency was/ is within quota, it is to mention here that the population or a part of population cannot be detached from the constituency owing to the fact that this will also decrease the quota besides the tribal rivalries is also a factum.
- J. That reasons to make the constituency would be the harmony between the local population and their convenience which principle has been violated while notifying the preliminary



constituencies, hence required to be

corrected.

It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that preliminary delimitation of PB-23 Killa Abdullah may be revised by considering the following suggestion:-

Patwar Circle Aghbarg (population is 38198) and
Patwar Circle Farakhi (Population is 11371) may be
restored in PB-23 and removed from PB-22 as the
same were previously part of PB-23.
