SUBJECT:- REPRESENTATION CUM OBJECTIONS IN TERMS OF SECTION 21 OF THE ELECTIONS ACT, 2017 R/W RULE 12 OF ELECTION RULES, 2017 FURTHER R/W ARTICLE 218 (3) OF THE CONSTITUTION OF ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN 1973.

The applicant most respectfully submits as under:-

- 1. That the applicant is a registered voter of

 The Union Council Conferming in Tehsil

 District Kech Balochistan now part of PB 48- Kech
 IV and NA 271, Shumariati Code No. 481080393 Silsila

 No. 77 as such, interested in democratic norms, election in the country, particularly in the delimitation of his own constituency, hence has a right to make representation and raise a voice against incorrect delimitation process.
- 2. That the above constituency is part of Balochistan which is the largest province in measurement but smallest in population, the area of this part of country is 347190 Square Kilometer while the population is 12344739, to National Assembly sixteen general seats have been allocated for Balochistan in the forthcoming elections, whereas three are meant for women. Similarly in Provincial Assembly fifty one seats of Provincial Assembly's candidates are to be elected directly while eleven and three seats have been reserved to women and the minorities respectively.

3. That the constituencies of National Assembly in Balochistan are based on some data which has recently been notified by this Commission, detail whereof is given below:-

- 5. That reason to reproduce the details of para No.3 & 4 in this representation is to highlight many things unnatural, i.e. areas, population etc of some constituencies which are apparent on the face of record.
- 6. That if one has to examine the material relating to that area, from naked eye it appears that some areas which are not the natural part of the constituency have been added in the constituency wrongly and against the spirit of law and scheme of delimitation.
- 7. That in the circumstances, the petitioner being a registered voter of NA/ PB in question i.e. NA-271 and PB-48 Kech-IV is aggrieved/ interested to correct the wrong made in preliminary delimitation to file this representation cum objection on the following amongst other grounds:-

GROUNDS

A. That till now the final census report has not been published, as such, the whole exercise appear to be premature.

- B. That there are no similarities while making the constituencies in respect of areas and population, hence on this count too it is bad.
- C. That the maps of the constituencies prepared by this Commission have been supplied late besides are incorrect and do not tally with the maps of Survey department even it is not in consonance of Goggle maps, hence the commission may look into.
- D. That the criteria meant in the Election Act, 2017 and the rules have been ignored resulting miscarriage of justice.
- E. That an areas/ union councils Sool Band and Kalatook were previously part of PB-46 Kech-II, but in the instant delimitation, the same have been removed from the PB-46 Kech-II and added in PB-48 Kech-IV, it may also be not out of place to note here that the said union councils have no relevancy or nexus with PB-48, hence the delimitation to this extent is required to be revived.
- F. That the criteria meant in the Election Act, 2017 and the rules have been ignored resulting miscarriage of justice.
- G. That there is no economic, cultural, cognitive and social relationship between the areas which have

been removed from PB-46 and added in PB-48, as such, required to be removed.

F. That furthermore, the population of the constituency was/ is within quota, it is to mention here that the population or a part of population cannot be attached in the constituency owing to the fact that this will also increase the quota.

That reasons to make the constituency would be to bring the harmony between the local population and their convenience which principle has been violated while notifying the preliminary constituencies, hence required to be corrected.

It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that preliminary delimitation of PB-48 Kech-IV may be revised by removing the Union Councils Sool Band and Kalatook from PB-48 Kech-IV and restoring the same in PB-46 Kech-II, with any other relief in the interest of justice.
