Memorandum of Representation / Objection under section 21 (3) Election
Act 2017 Read with rule 11.12 of election rules 2017 to the draft proposal in
respect of delimitation of pk-36-37-38 and Pk -39 of District Abbottabad

The petitioners who are registered voters in the proposed constituency PK-37 district Abbottabad, with due respect submit following representations/objection petition against proposed delimitation of PK-37, Abbottabad-II proposed by ECP. (Copy of proposed delimitation notification attached as Annexure- A).

- 1. District Abbottabad is spread over 18013 km2 area having steep hilly terrain. The population of the district according to the censuses 2017 is about 1.330 million. According to election Act, 2017, Sec-20, Principles of Delimitation, all constituencies for general seats shall, as for as practicable, be delimited having regard to the distribution of population shall in geographically compact areas, physical features, existing boundaries of administrative units, facilities of communication and public convenience and other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity in the creation of constituencies.
- 2. In view of the above laid down principles we hereby submit our legal objections and proposals to preliminary list of Provincial Assembly constituency Pk-36, 37, 38 and Pk-39 District Abbottabad.
  - a. Patwar Circle Chatrri, which constitutes of a total population of 13833 persons have historically remained part of formerly PK-44 now PK-39. The communication of this Patwar Circle originate and culminate in Pk-39, and has no homogeneity or social connectivity with the people of PK -37 to which it has been attach to. The language, culture and social bondage of the people of PC Chatri have always been woven into the social fabric of the people of present PK 39 and not with PK 37 to which it has been wrongly attached.
  - b. Patwar Circles namely Bandi Atai Khan, Garhi Phulgran, Rajoya, and Langra have been deprived of homogeneity by being separated from the same kind of majority population inhabited in the neighboring Patwar Circles namely (i) Kokal, (ii) Havelian PC, and (iii) Jahngran. Moreover, Patwar Circles Kokal and Langra fall within the same Qanungo Halqa which have been seperated. The population of this area is 143745 (PC Kokal 106645, PC Jhangran 15818, Havelian PC 21282) but a part and

parcel of this population ie. PC Bandi Atai Khan 17533, PC Rajoya 14053, PC Garhi Phulgran 13329 and PC Langra 25746, totaling 70661 has been divided/split from the adjoining majority population defeating the principle of homogeneity of population and seriously compromising their ability to choose the political representatives of

- c. Present PK-37 constitutes the most treacherous, hazardous, unsafe, mountainous and difficult to approach hilly areas. Moreover, it spread on a vast and biggest geographical expanse with minimal road communication facilities. It would be pertinent to attach some of the plain and easily approachable urban area to PK 37 to somewhat balance the ease of approach as compared to other constituencies.
- d. In the preliminary list of constituencies there has been violation of sub section 1 of section 20 of the election act 2017 by not keeping the existing boundaries intact, which provides to keep the existing boundaries of the existing administrative units intact as for as practicable. The boundaries of administrative units have been divided/split gravely effecting and disturbing the natural homogeneity of population in total disregard of the Principles of Delimitation as laid down in the Election Act
- e. While creating preliminary list of constituencies, the geographical compact area and public convenience also has not been considered due to which the public will suffer

Without Prejudice to above legal objections, constituency wise proposals are as under:
