REPRESENTATION

UNDER SECTION 21(3) OF THE ELECTIONS ACT, 2017 READ WITH RULE 12 OF THE ELECTION RULES AGAINST PRELIMINARY/DRAFT DELIMITATION PREPARED AND PUBLISHED BY THE ELECTION COMMISSION OF PAKISTAN IN RESPECT OF PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY CONSTITUENCY NO. PK-70, PESHAWAR.

The petitioner, namely Syed Muhamamd Ishtiaq (Urmar) son of Syed Mumtaz Ali Shah, R/o Urmar Payan, District Peshawar, and another, are registered voter of District Peshawar. (copies of CNIC and voter certificates are attached).

- 2. The Honorable Election Commission of Pakistan has notified preliminary list of constituencies of Provincial Assemblies KPK vide notification, dated 05-03-2018 and invited objections there-at.
- 3. The petitioner, being voter, registered in Tehsil Peshawar, has felt aggrieved by preliminary list of Constituencies of Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pukhtunkhwa in respect of Tehsil Peshawar, District Peshawar and hereby submit following observations and present my proposals to delimit the fourteen(14) Provincial Assembly Constituencies of the District.

LEGAL:-

- 4. The Elections Act, 2017 and rules made there-under empower the Honorable Election Commission of Pakistan to delimit the Constituencies of Local Government, National & Provincial Assembly Constituencies as per guidance provided in the Act and elaborated in The Elections Rules, 2017 respectively. Chapter-III of The Elections Act, 2017 provide detailed guidance in the matter. Section 20 of the Act, specifically provides detail whereof, namely:-

 - (2)
 - (3) As far as possible, variation in population of constituencies of an Assembly or a local government shall not ordinarily exceed ten percent.

If the limit of ten percent under sub-section (3) is exceeded in an exceptional case, the Commission shall record reasons thereof in the delimitation order.

- Further, the Elections Rules, 2017, directs as under:-5.
 - The Commission after allocation Determination of quota.----(1) seats referred to in rule 7, determine the average population (hereinafter referred to as "quota per seat") of a constituency for each province, the Tribal Areas and the Federal Capital by dividing total population thereof by general seats in the National Assembly allocated to a Province, the Tribal Areas or, as the case may be, the Federal Capital.
 - (2).
 - (3)
 - The Commission shall determine and notify the share of a district or districts, by dividing total population thereof with the quota per seat of the (4)Provincial Assembly concerned as determined under this rule.
- The Honorable Election Commission of Pakistan vide its Notification No.F.8(3)/2018-Elec-I, dated 5th March, 2018 has worked out quota per seat in each Provincial Assembly (in its para-16) i.e.

The Elections Rules, 2018, directed the Delimitation Committees that :-

Draft proposals for delimitation of constituencies.---- (1) Delimitation Committee constituted under Rule 9 shall, immediately after its -constitution, proceed to obtain from Pakistan Bureau of Statistics, population data of last census official published along with relevant maps showing therein census charges, census circles and census blocks along with description, relating to a province, a district, an agency, or any other administrative or revenue unit as it may require

Provided that the quota under this sub-rule shall be determined by dividing total population of the district or the agency with number of seats allocated to that district or agency.

The Delimitation Committee shall also obtain district maps along with description, duly authenticated by Pakistan Bureau of Statistics, or , as the case may be, the district head of Revenue Department, prepared on a uniform scale as may be determined by the Commission indicating therein details of all administrative and revenue units in the district to the level of a Patwar Circle or, as the case may be, a Tapedar Circle, as well as prominent geographical and physical features, such as rivers and mountains and any other information as may be determined by the Commission or required by the Committee.

- 9. The petitioner, in order to prepare and submit the objections/representation against the draft/preliminary list of constituencies, obtained copies of the relevant maps from the provincial headquarters of Election Commission of Pakistan at Peshawar, which are being used in preparation of this representation.
- 10. And in view of proviso to Rule-10, the total population of district Peshawar i.e. . 42,69,079 was divided by total number of seats allocated to district, and thus:4269079/14 = 3,04,934 was the quota per seat in district Peshawar.

GROUNDS OF REPRESENTATION/MEMORANDUM:-

- a) Detailed study of notification containing list of constituencies and the maps, further, showed that respective Delimitation Committee, did not took care of indications on the map pointing out limits of Patwar Circles, Roads, Rivers, etc. which are dividing the areas of the district nor they kept in mind the public facility. Further, the Delimitation Committee also could not take care of compactness of a proposed constituency in this district.
- (b) Due to lack of this such basic requisite knowledge of the important information, the Delimitation Committee was not in position to take into consideration the importance of Administrative and Revenue units, compactness of different portions of district, Road infrastructure, Bridges, Nullas, Rivers, cultural links, facilities/easements of voters, floods, etc., and hence the Delimitation Committee only focused on equalizing the population of different areas of District Peshawar, which is evident from establishment of some of the Constituencies of the District for Provincial Assembly.

ON FACTS:

- (i) District Peshawar is a district, surrounded by Nullahs, Rivers, Rainy areas and different cultural boundaries are spread over the whole district, which were not considered by Delimitation Committee..
- (ii) The Delimitation Committee, further did not took care the direction that Patwar Circle will not be broken in any case and hence, broken Administrative as well as Revenue Units un-necessarily.
- (iii) Two PCs namely Wad Paga has been notified as part of PK-68, but as is showing in ECP map, which is creating over-laping in PK-69, which over-laping is required to be removed.
- (iv) Major portion of PC namely Pakha Ghulam is included in PK-68, whereas, by breaking the said PC, a portion thereof namely Chughalpura is detached from the PC and is included in PK-69, the said anomaly is required to be removed.
- (v) Similarly, as per ECP map, major portion of PC Larma has been made part of PK-67, whereas a portion of said PC namely Garhi Balochan has been included in PK-69.
- (vi) Again, as per ECP map, major portion of Barbar PC has been included in PK-67, whereas another portion of said PC namely Haji Zai has been included in PK-66.
- (vii) Specifically, the petitioner is resident of Village Urmar Payan, which has been made part of PK-69, belong to Syed Gharana and have very much respect since his forefathers. The petitioner is active member of Pakistan Tehreek e Insaf Peshawar and was elected as Member of Provincial Assembly from PK-11.

Whereas, the petitioner being family member of Syeds, have prominent number of religious followers in the area, which was earlier known as PF-7, and during last elections, as PK-11. Now, the Delimitation Committee, for the reasons best known to them, had side-lined our residential area to another and different constituency, and had thus practically side-lined this family, who have thousands of religious followers, as well as, who have strong political influence and background, just to create difference between religious and political followers.

Furthermore, the Urmar Bala, Urmar Miana and Urmar Payan, as clear from the common "Urmar" having the same culture, families, relationship language and socio economic center is long linkage, if not corrected, will amount to bifurcation of one Tribe (Qaum) and it will definitely cause damage to the cause of Election Commission towards fair and free elections.

IN VIEW OF ABOVE OBJECTIONS/OBSERVATIONS, THE FOLLOWING CHANGES IN THE DRAFT CONSTITUENCIES ARE PROPOSED :-
