Representation under section 21 of the Elections Act, 2017, read with rule 12 of the Election Rules, 2017 in respect of the delimitation of constituencies of Provincial Assembly of Punjab in District Sheikhupura particularly concerning proposed constituencies PP-136 and PP-142

Respectfully Sheweth:-

- 1. That the Petitioner is a permanent resident and voter of Mandiala, Patwar Circle Qila Amir Singh, Tehsil and District Sheikhupura. He is a social worker, politician and an elected councillor (General Member) from Ward No. 4, Union Council No. 46 namely Mandiala Virkan, Tehsil and District Sneikhupura. Welfare and betterment of people of his local area are paramount considerations for the Petitioner and he has been struggling for the same for a long time.
- 2. That the Preliminary Delimitation Report, 2018 proposes the delimitation of nine (09) constituencies of Provincial Assembly of Punjab in District Sheikhupura and the same have been published by the Honourable Commission. Relevant pages of the Form 5 pertaining to Provincial Assembly of Punjab are appended with this Representation. Since this Representation pertains to only two constituencies of Provincial Assembly from District Sheikhupura namely PP-136 and PP-142 therefore it is expedient to incorporate their details in this petition for ease of reference

3. That through the instant representation, the petitioner craves the gracious indulgence of this Honourable Commission to delimit the constituencies no. PP - 136 and PP - 142 in the following manner:

4. That being aggrieved by and dissatisfied with the part of list of constituencies, published in the Preliminary Delimitation Report, 2018, particularly specifying the areas proposed to be included in / excluded from proposed Provincial Assembly constituencies PP – 136 and PP – 142 of District Sheikhupura and in the best interest of the population of the district as a whole, the Petitioner craves the kind indulgence of this Honourable Commission for making amendments, alterations or modifications as suggested / proposed by the Petitioner in paragraph 3 above, *inter alia*, on the following

Grounds

- (a) That a combined reading of section 20 of the Elections Act, 2017 and rule 10 of the Election Rules, 2017 reveals that the following principles and procedures are to be kept in mind at the time of making the delimitation of the constituencies:
 - (i) Distribution of population in geographically compact areas
 - (ii) Physical features
 - (iii) Existing boundar es of administrative units
 - (iv) Facilities of communication
 - (v) Public convenience
 - (vi) Other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity
 - (vii) The delimitation of constituencies of an Assembly shall start from the Northern end of the district; and
 - (viii) Then it will proceed clock-wise in zigzag manner keeping in view that population among the constituencies of an Assembly shall remain as close as may be practicable
 - (ix) The variation in population between two or more constituencies shall not ordinarily exceed ten percent



- (b) That while preparing the Preliminary Delimitation Report, 2018 comprising of proposals for fresh delimitation of constituencies for Provincial Assembly in Sheikhupura District especially proposed PP 136 and PP 142, it is respectfully submitted, the relevant Delimitation Committee failed to adhere to the above stated mandatory principles and procedures in letter and spirit therefore there is a need to revisit the said delimitation proposal by this Honourable Commission.
- (c) That while preparing delimitation report for proposed constituency PP 142, the Delimitation Committee excluded the Patwar Circle of QH Sheikhupura of Tehsil Sheikhupura namely Qila Amir Singh and included the same in proposed constituency PP 135. It is to be noted here that the said areas excluded from proposed PP 142 and included in proposed PP 136 had throughout remained a part of such constituencies of the Provincial Assembly forming major parts of Sheikhupura Tehsil since 1985 delimitation because of the guiding factors such as geographical compactness, facilities of communication and public convenience.
- (d) Similarly, Patwar Circle of QH Sheikhupura of Tehsil Sheikhupura namely Qila Amir Singh has wrongly been included in proposed PP 136 and a result of, it is respectfully submitted, non-application of mind by the relevant Delimitation Committee because the inclusion of this Patwar Circle in proposed PP 136 is a blatant violation of principles of delimitation as mandated by section 20 of the Elections Act, 2017.
 - (i) This Patwar Circle does not form a geographically compact part of proposed PP 136 and such inclusion has created a pocket in the proposed constituency, hence violation of principle of distribution of population in geographically compact areas.
 - (ii) This Patwar Circles is like a chicken neck of the proposed PP 136 and there is no direct access for the population of this Patwar circle towards main PP 136, hence violation of principle of facilities of communication.
 - (iii) Since this Patwar Circles do not form a geographically compact area of the proposed PP 136 and badly suffer from lack of facilities of communication, the population of this Patwar Circles would have to travel *firstly* in PP 140 and then PP 142 to catch Main Muridke Road in order to reach main PP 136, hence violation of principle of public convenience.



- (e) That if the proposal for delimitation of PP 136 and PP 142 made by the Delimitation Committee in its Preliminary Delimitation Report, 2018 is finalised without incorporating a mendments, alterations or modifications proposed / suggested by the Petitioner in paragraph 3 above, the entire population of above mentioned Patwar Circle would suffer irreparable loss and hardships and their miseries would increase manifold.
- (f) That the amendments, alterations or modifications proposed / suggested by the Petitioner in paragraph 3 above are for the sole purpose of providing facilities and ease to the inhabitants of the said areas.

In view of the foregoing, it is most respectfully prayed that the instant representation may kindly be accepted and the amendments, alterations or modifications proposed / suggested by the Petitioner in paragraph 3 of this representation may graciously be incorporated in the final report and list of constituencies showing the areas included in each constituency.

Any other relief which this Honourable Commission may deem just and appropriate may also be granted to the Petitioner in the interest of law, justice and equity.
