**REPRESENTATION U/S 21(3) OF THE ELECTION ACT, 2017 AGAINST
THE PRELIMINARY DELIMITATION OF THE CONSTITUENCY IN
RESPECT OF PP-202 CHICHAWATNI DISTRICT SAHIWAL NOTIFIED
ON 05.03.2018**

Respected Sir,

With reference to notification No.F.8(3)/2018-Elec-1 dated 05.03.2018, regarding publication of preliminary report, of delimitation of constituencies of National Assemblies and provincial Assemblies, We hereby filed objections against the above said preliminary delimitation of provincial constituency PP-202 as under:-

- i. That the principles laid down in section 20 of the Election Act, 2017 and Rule 12 of the Election Rules, 2017 have not been complied with in strict-senso.
- ii. That geographically compact area means which naturally and politically division of the earth seems to be one unit. Unfortunately, the preliminary delimitation in respect of PP-202 Chichawatni District Sahiwal is not in consonance with the geographical nature of the area. The main Multan Road bifurcates the two provincial constituencies PP-202 and PP-201. In the preliminary delimitation the inclusion of PC 41/14L (5 Km away from Multan Road) is incompatible with the geography of the constituency PP-202. A cursory view of the map itself indicates that the proposed delimitation is more appropriate in the light of this principle rather than the preliminary notified delimitation. The patwar circle of Chak No. 41/14-L includes chak No.39/14-L,

- L having population 11,431 have been included in PP-202 whereas previously the PP-202 was PP-226 and this patwar circle was not included in PP-226.
- iii. That Patwar Circle 100/12-L and 102/12-L have been excluded from PP-202 whereas previously in PP-226 these Patwar Circles were included therein having total population 15,431 and due to this proposed delimitation the compactness of the constituency has been materially effected.
- iv. That if the Patwar Circle 41/14-L be excluded from PP-202 and Patwar Circle 100/12-L & 102/12-L be included in PP-202 then there will be a compactness and boundaries will be upon a strengthen of natural boundary and will be well within principle of delimitation set out by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan as well as Election Rules, 2017. The proposed delimitation is natural.
- v. That the preliminary and proposed delimitation is given hereunder in an annotated form:
