REPRESENTATION

UNDER SECTION 21(3) OF THE ELECTION ACT. 2017 READ WITH RULE 12 AND 13 OF THE ELECTION RULES-2017 FOR ALTERATION/MODIFICATIONS IN THE DELIMITATION OF CONSTITUENCIES PP 99-100, 101 & 102 OF THE DISTRICT FAISALABAD.

Respectfully Sheweth,

1. That the undersigned is a registered voter of Chak No. 363/GB, Vote No. 49, Voter of PP-101 N.A 103 District Faisalabad.
2. That the Election Commission of Pakistan and the Delimitation Committee constituted by the Election Commission of Pakistan is to follow the principle as described in Section 20 of the Election Act, 2017 for delimitation of constituencies for National and Provincial Assembly, which is reproduced as below.

20. Principals of delimitation.—(1) All constituencies for general seats shall, as far as practicable, be delimited having regard to the distribution of population in geographically compact areas, physical features, existing boundaries of administrative units, facilities of communication and public convenience and other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity in the creation of constituencies.

3. That the District Faisalabad has lost one Provincial Assembly seat as the total population of district Faisalabad is 78,73,910 according to the latest census conducted in 2017. The delimitation of constituencies in Faisalabad

has got great importance as any unfair practice shall question the whole electoral process negatively.

4 That a combined reading of section 20 of the Election Act, 2017 and rule 10 of the Election Rules, 2017 reveals that the following principles and procedures are to be kept in mind at the time of making the delimitation of the constituencies:

- (i) Distribution of population in geographically compact areas.
- ii). Physical features
- iii). Existing boundaries of administrative units.
- iv). Facilities of Communication.
- v). Public convenience
- vi). other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity
- vii). the delimitation of constituencies of an Assembly shall start from the Northern end of the district; and
- viii). Then it will proceed clock-wise in zigzag manner Keeping in view that population among the constituencies of an Assembly shall remain as close as may be practicable.
- ix). the variation in population between two or more constituencies shall not ordinarily exceed then percent.

5. That the preliminary delimitation of constituencies published by Election commission of Pakistan will cause serious inconvenience to the public at large of District Faisalabad, if same are not altered or modified in accordance with the provisions of the Election Act. 2017.

6. That the detailed delimitation plan of the constituencies 99-100-101-102 according to the report of delimitation committee is annexed as **ANNEXURE A**.

7. That the undersigned is willing to propose a delimitation plan that is most suited in terms of Section 20 of the Election Act. 2017.


