# **REPRESENTATION**

UNDER SECTION 21(3) OF THE ELECTION ACT, 2017 READ WITH RULE 12 and 13 OF THE ELECTION RULES-2017 FOR ALTERATION/MODIFICATION IN THE DELIMITATION OF CONSTITUENCIES PP 102 & PP 103 OF THE DISTRICT FAISALABAD:-

Respectfully Sheweth,

- 1. That the undersigned is a registered voter of PP103, NA 103 of Faisalabad District.
- 2. That the Election Commission of Pakistan and the Delimitation Committee constituted by the Election Commission of Pakistan is to follow the principle as described in Section 20 of the Election Act, 217 for delimitation of constituencies for National and Provincial Assembly, which is reproduced as below
  - 20. Principles of delimitation.—(1) All constituencies for general seats shall, as far as practicable, be delimited having regard to the distribution of population in geographically compact areas, physical features, existing boundaries of administrative units, facilities of communication and public convenience and other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity in the creation of constituencies.
- 3. That the District Faisalabad has lost one Provincial Assembly seat as the total population of district Faisalabad is **78**, **73**, **910** according to the latest census conducted in 2017. The delimitation of constituencies in Faisalabad has got great importance as any unfair practice shall question the whole electoral process negatively.

- 4. That the following principles are to be followed while finalizing the delimitation of constituencies under Section 20 of the Elections Act- 2017.
  - i. Distribution of population in geographically compact areas
  - ii. Physical features
  - iii. Existing boundaries of administrative units,
  - iv. Facilities of communication and public convenience
  - v. Cognate factors to ensure homogeneity in the creation of constituencies
- 5. That the preliminary delimitation of constituencies published by Election commission of Pakistan will cause serious inconvenience to the public at large of District Faisalabad, if same are not altered or modified in accordance with the provisions of the Election Act- 2017.
- 6. That the detailed delimitation plan of the constituencies PP 101, PP102, PP103 according to the report of delimitation committee is annexed as **ANNEXURE A**.
- 7. That the PP102 is comprised of an area of three tehsils of District Faisalabad including Samundri, Tandlianwala and Jaranwala, which is causing confusion and uncertainty among the public at large.
- 8. That the undersigned is willing to propose a delimitation plan that is most suited in terms of Section 20 of the Election Act 2017.

#### PROPOSED PLAN

Patwar Circle (PC) 366/G.B and Patwar Circle(PC) 367/G.B of Rodala Qanugo Halqa, Tehsil Jaranwala may be excluded from the constituency(PP102) as the area is situated in between three constituencies and is very difficult to approach from the other areas of PP102. Population of both the Patwar Circles is 9570 and 7200 respectively which is annexed as ANNEXURE B.

PC 366/GB and PC 367/GB were historically part of PP56 adjacent to other Patwar Circles of Pindi Sheikh Musa QH of Tehsil Tandlianwala which were part of the same constituency and are closer and easy to approach each other. These two patwar circles may be added to PP103 from PP102 to balance the population and to make it convenient for the local residents.

Patwar Circle (PC) 603/GB being at the edge of the Tandlianwala QH of Tehsil Tandlianwala and Patwar Circle (PC) 601/GB may be added to the PP102 from PP103. The population of both the Patwar Circles is 7644 and 8054 respectively. The population table is annexed as ANNEXURE C
