REPRESENTATION UNDER SECTION 21(3) OF THE ELECTION ACT 2017 READ WITH RULE 11 (4) OF THE ELECTION RULES 2017 FOR THE DE-LIMITATION OF THE PROPOSED CONSTITUENCY NO.PP-181 KASOOR IN THE PRELIMINARY REPORT

ABSTRACT

Petitioners being the local resident representatives propose a change in the constituency PP-181 Kasur with the following observations:



- (a) That the petitioners are enrolled as a voter in the constituency No. PP=180, Kasur.
- (b) That the preliminary delimitation of constituencies has been published through public notice by the respondent. Copy of notice is attached.
- (c) That the preliminary delimitation of constituency NO.PP-180, Kasur is against law, facts, rules, procedures, principles and provisions as well as sections laid down in the delimitation Act 2017.
- (d) That there is gross violation of laws, rules, principles and sections of delimitation rules 2017.
- (e) That the delimitation of PP-180 along with PP-181Kasur is liable to be rectified to the extent of prayer of the petitioners to meet the ends of justice and to be in accordance with rules, provisions, laws sections laid down in the delimitation Act 2017.
- 1. Khanke Mor presently proposed in PP-180 be removed/excluded and added in PP-181.
- 2. The population of "Khanke Mor" is 16,300/-. The reasons for praying this are as follows:
 - a) Patwar circle Khanke Mor has always been an integral part of the main urban area Phool Nagar which is in PP-



- b) All the public facilities and public utilities of Phool Nagar are available and used by the inhabitants of Khanke Mor being adjacent to urban area of Phool Nagar. The relations of Khanke Mor and their business interests are in the commercial areas of Phool Nagar. The relationships (Baradarism) the land contiguity and its situation justifies the addition of Khanke More into PP-181 as it's the public convenience that is to be primarily considered.
- c) Since "Khanke Mor" has been an integral part of the same land mass i.e. now been proposed to be added in PP-181. It would be relevant to mention here that since last five decades, the three Zila Council Chairman Rana Muhammad Iqbal, Rana Muhammad Ishaque and Sikandar Hayat, all Members/Chairman of the Union Council "Khanke Mor" have been elected as Zila Council Chairmen over the area now form PP-181 which establishes the fact that Khanke Mor is an integral part of the area comprising in PP-181.

It would be further relevant to mention that the exclusion of "Khanke Mor" Patwar Circle is intentional.

not a bonafide error and tantamounts to an unwarranted burden and may be due to "gerrymandering" as the exclusion of Khanke Mor is actually creating a political gap in PP-181.

- 4. The patwar circles "Roosa Bhel" population 21,000 and "Buchoke Majah" population 6,062, of these two patwar circles have been missing from the constituencies PP-181 adjacent to them.
- 5. They are not being shown as the part of any PP constituency.
- 6. There has been a bonafide mistake/error which has crept into the record of PP-181 duly notified which shows as population of 3,82,047/- when calculated in accordance areas form part of PP-181 which are as follows:

Thus there is a difference of 27062 population in the total calculation as notified by the Election Commission of Pakistan which is 382,047.

Therefore, in case the Khanke Mor is added, the natural result would be the total population 354,985 can be reached.

Population balance: In case "Khanke Mor" 16,300 is taken away out of 390,198 of PP-180 the remaining population shall be 3,73,898 and shall remain within 10% threshold.

PROPOSAL

- a. The Quota per seat for the province of Punjab and existing population as per 2017 Census is given under:
 - i. Quota per seat =370,000 with 10% plus minus.
 - ii. Existing Population of PP-181 = 382,047
 - iii. Existing population of PP-180 = 390,198

Therefore the proposed exclusion of Khanke More PC having Population of 16,300 being proposed in PP-180 and be removed and added into PP-181, does not alter the population distribution of the constituencies; After the above-mentioned proposal the new population for PP-181 and PP-180 shall become;

iv. Existing Population of PP-181 = 382,047

➢ By ADDITION of 16,300 population of Khanke Mor PC, makes the population of PP-181 = 398,347.

v. Existing population of PP-180 = 390,198

- ➢ By reduction of 16,300 population of Khanke Mor from PP 180, makes the population of PP-373,898 which falls within the Quota.
- **b.** The above mentioned facts and grounds shall make the population distribution of the PP-180 and PP-181 as under:
