

MEMORANDUM OF REPRESENTATION TO THE PRELIMINARY DELIMITATION IN RESPECT OF THE CONSTITUENCIES NA-225, NA-226, NA-227 & PS-63, PS-62,PS-64,PS-65 AND PS-66 OF HYDERABAD DISTRICT

The Petitioner above-named most respectfully submits as under:-

1. The Petitioner is a voter in PS-63 (Hyderabad-II, comprise of Taluka Hyderabad Rural) & NA-225 (HYDERABAD-I), and has contested Local Bodies Election in the year 2015 for number of Union Councils in Taluka Hyderabad Rural of District Hyderabad. Accordingly, the Petitioner is directly aggrieved by Preliminary Delimitation in respect to the area, therefore, hereinafter proposes amendments in Preliminary Delimitation of constituencies of District Hyderabad, keeping in view the principles of delimitation i.e. compactness, contiguity, territorial unit homogeneity and population as encapsulated in Election Act, 2017. Copy of voter's list and CNIC is enclosed as Annex A & A-1.



- 2. The Preliminary Delimitation is squarely against the statutory Principles of Delimitation, as enshrined in Section 20 of the Election Act, 2017, and the criteria laid down in the dictums by the Supreme Court of the Country. Delimitation. Said Preliminary Delimitation in respect to District Hyderabad seems unbalanced and discriminatory, which in-turn leave an impression of gerrymandering.
- 3. Following is the proposal of the Petitioner on Preliminary Delimitation report for NA-225 (HYDERABAD-I) comprising of PS-63 (Hyderabad-II)& PS-62 (Hyderabad-I, is spelt out as under:-

Proposed areas inclusion for PS-63:-

i) (a) Tepedar Circle Kathri of Hatri STC, (b) Tapedar Circle Hatri of Hatri STC and, (c) Tapedar Circle of Additional Kathri STC of District Hyderabad. Said mentioned areas may be included in PS-63 on various grounds amongst others, :- (i) said mentioned areas are geographically rural areas and their inclusion in PS-62, which is primarily an urban area, in-turn, would lead to administrative neglect and budget confinements as well, (ii) cognate factor holds water over here in terms of the fact that exclusion of said area might lead to a law and order situation and, thus disturbing social fabric of the society (iii) administratively said areas are part of District Council Hyderabad (Hyderabad




Rural Taluka) (iv) Public convenience also advocates the inclusion of said area in PS-63.

Town Committee Husri may also be included in PS-63, on various grounds:- (i) Town Committee Husri comes under Tapedar Circle Husri, which in-turn consists of 03 dehs (i) Alni (ii) Panhwari (iii) Kathro. Evident Gerrymandering in this context exists by shifting Town Committee Husri (part of T.C. Husri) in Latifabad Taluka, which normally otherwise would have been a full shift of T.C. Husri. remained has area said (ii) (formerly historically/geographically in PS-63 known as PS-50).






Following areas may be included to PS-62 on belowmentioned grounds:-

- a) Circle No.1, 2, 3, 5 of Census charge No.1 of Taluka Latifabad, Hyderabad.
- b) Census Charge No.17 & 18 of Taluka City, Hyderabad
- i) Said areas principally comprise of Sindhi linguistic community and therefore on cognate grounds need not to be disturbed and merging it with the area (i.e. PS-65 and PS-66 respectively) which mainly comprises of Urdu Community and historically rivalry has been seen between both communities, therefore merging it with PS-65 and PS-66 would lead to in-orderly situation. (ii) historically it has also remained part of PS-62 (formerly known as PS-47) (iii) said areas are geographically compact as well and therefore deserve to remain in PS-62.





- i) As far as public convenience and physical communication i.e. lay-out of road network and allied infrastructure are in question,



said areas are well-connected through main road of District Hyderabad to District Tando Muhammad Khan, therefore, general population would reach out to administrative offices/units conveniently through mentioned road/network rather than what would exist as a result of newly proposed delimitations by the ECP. Further, Public representatives and voters would remain disconnect/distant owing to said reason of said areas (inaccessibility) (ii) network approximately 15 kilometers of physical boundaries with Taluka Latifabad, PS-64 (formerly known as PS-49) (iii) population has already been and still is resident of PS-64, therefore such a dismantling would only lead to a further chaotic Political scenario and administrative failure. (iv) Aforementioned areas were formerly part of Provincial Assembly Seat of Tando Muhammad Khan District.
