

REPRESENTATION UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE ELECTIONS ACT, 2017 READ WITH RULE 12 OF THE ELECTION RULES 2017 AGAINST THE DELIMITATION OF PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY CONSTITUENCIES PS-80, PS-81 & PS-82 OF DISTRICT JAMSHORO, SINDH

Being aggrieved and dis-satisfied with the delimitation proposal dated 05.03.2018 notified by ECP for the Provincial Assembly seats of District Jamshoro, the Petitioners submit the instant Representation on the following facts & grounds: GROUNDS:

- 1. That Taluka Manjhand is a part of District Jamshoro, which as per the notified Census results, has a population of 140,840 people. As per the preliminary proposal regarding delimitation of constituencies published by the ECP, Taluka Manjhand has been divided into two (02) parts. While one part of Manjhand having a population of 78,111 (55% of the entire Taluka) has been made part of proposed PS-80 (previously PS-73), the remaining part with a population 62,729 (44.50% of the entire Taluka) has been made part of the proposed PS-81 (previously PS-72).
- 2. That if one looks at the historical perspective of Taluka Manjhand, one would notice that Manjhand was given the status of Taluka in the year 2005 and until 2005, Manjhand had remained part of Kotri Taluka. In this regard, it is imperative to state here that Manjhand as a Taluka has only been carved out of Kotri. Therefore, there is a great deal of historical, cultural & physical connection between Manjhand & Kotri but also homogeneity in both these areas. Needless to mention here that in all of the previous elections, major portion of Manjhand & Kotri were part of the same Provincial Assembly constituency.
- 3. That as per the proposal, almost half of Taluka Manjhand has been made part of PS-81, which predominantly comprises of Taluka Thano Bhula Khan. Besides, having no historical connection with Thano Bhula Khan, another important aspect which seems to have missed the attention of ECP is the fact that there is also no physical connection between Taluka Manjhand & Thano Bhula Khan. It is most pertinent to mention here that both the Talukas are naturally divided by mountains and interestingly, there is no road network directly connecting the two Talukas. This can be further fortified from the fact that a person from Thano Bhula Khan to reach Taluka Manjhand would have to first exit District Jamshoro, enter District Thatta, get onto Super Highway, then enter Kotri (PS-82), to finally get access to Taluka Manjhand. This fact is also confirmed by letters from the office of Deputy Commissioner, Jamshoro & Executive Engineer Highways, Jamshoro.

4. That the total population of District Jamshoro is 993,142 people and as per the formula adopted by ECP under the applicable laws, a total of three (03) Provincial Assembly seats have been allocated to District Jamshoro. In the proposal published by ECP, following is the population break-up of the three (03) constituencies:

- 5. That a perusal of the above clearly shows that all the four (04) Talukas of District Jamshoro have been broken up in haphazard manner and also in deviation of the principles of delimitation contained in Section 20 of The Elections Act, 2017 as well as numerous judgments enunciating similar principles.
- 6. That keeping in view the principle of public convenience as well as geographical, historical and physical contiguity, the major portion of Taluka Manjhand should be part of PS-82 and the remaining portion should be added into PS-80 (in order to complete the population numbers for PS-80) and consequently renumbered. The exact bifurcation is stated in the proposal contained in Para 8 of this representation. PROPOSAL:

7. That for the reasons that have been highlighted above, the following proposal is

- 8. That the variation between the seats as proposed above with the highest and lowest population is 8.99% which is within the limit contained in the applicable laws. Moreover, the above arrangement comprises of areas, which are geographically contiguous with the best possible communication network amongst them. Furthermore, it is also closest to the previous delimitation done in the year 2002 thus facilitating the voters & more importantly electoral process in the respective constituencies.
- 9. That it is most pertinent to mention here that even at the time of the last delimitations which took place in the year 2002, the major portion of Manjhand was initially aligned with Taluka Thano Bhula Khan in the preliminary delimitation to create PS-72. In this regard, reliance is placed upon the preliminary report on delimitation of constituencies published on 26.03.2002. However, upon objections made by residents of Manjhand, the constituencies were re-aligned resulting in Manjhand getting detached from Taluka Thano Bhula Khan. In this regard, reliance is placed upon the final delimitation, which was published in the Gazette of Pakistan dated 28.06.2002.


