

Representation Under Section 21 (3) of the Election Act, 2017 r/w the provisions of Chapter III, Part. A of the Election Rules, 2017 on behalf of the petitioner for making appropriate amendments, alterations and/or modifications in the preliminary list of proposed provincial constituencies of District Naushahro Feroze Sindh, inter alia, Proposed PS. 33, (Naushahro Feroze I)

The petitioner respectfully submits as follows:

- 1) That the petitioner is the voter and politician from District Naushahro Feroze who has contested election previously from the said district in particular from PS-21 Naushehro Feroz-III in the 2013 elections and secured 29997 votes whereas the returned candidate secured 30006 votes difference of only 9 votes. Further, the petitioner until recently has also served as Special Assistant to Chief Minister Sindh and twice elected as taluka nazim from the district Naushahro Feroze. It is relevant to point out that the petitioner was elected unopposed nazim taluka Mehrabpur. (Copy of the General Elections 2013 Report is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure R/1)
- 2) That Article 51 of the Constitution provides that there shall be 342 of the National Assembly including seats reserved for women and non-Muslims.

According to this Article 51, 61 General Seats and 14 reserved seats for women have been allocated to the province of Sindh for National Assembly. According to Article 106 of the constitution, 130 General seats, 29 Reserved Seats for women and 9 seats Reserved for minority have been allocated to the Province of Sindh for Provincial Assembly.

- 3) As far as District Naushahro Feroze is concerned, in general elections 2013, five provincial assembly constituencies represented the entire population of District Naushahro Feroze in that PS-19 Naushahro Feroze I, PS 20 Naushahro Feroze II, PS-21 Naushahro Feroze III, PS-22 Naushahro Feroze IV, PS-23 Naushahro Feroze V. Now the provincial constitutencies have been proposed for district Naushahro Feroze as PS-33 (Naushahro Feroze I); PS-34 (Naushahro Feroze II); PS-35 (Naushahro Feroze III) and PS 36 (Naushahro Feroze IV). Hence, one constituency is being reduced for district Naushahro Feroze of Sindh Province.
- 4) The instant representation is regarding the Provincial Constituency, PS-33 (Naushahro Feroze I). The petitioner hails from district Naushahro Feroze and is registered voter in PS-33 (Naushahro Feroze I). On behalf of the general public of PS-33, he is filing the titled representation as the proposed constituency; would adversely affect the rights and interests of the area for several reasons as, interalia, summarized hereinafter.
- 5) That preliminary proposal of delimitation for seats of Provincial assembly of Sindh for district Naushahro Feroze has been issued while ignoring the mandatory guidelines given in Section 20 of the Election Act 2017 and rules 7,8,9 and 10 of the Election Rules 2017.
- Naushahro Feroze I in utter disregard of the guiding principles of geographically compact areas, physical features of the areas, as proposed constituencies, the convenience is a major issue with public residing in these areas, the facilities of communication and public convenience has also been ignored. (Copy of the Preliminary Delimitation MAP and extent of constituency are annexed herewith and marked as Annexure R/2 and R/3 respectively)
- 7) That the proposed delimitation is nothing but a sheer exercise of curtailing the ways and means for public at large to participate in elections which amount to Gerry meandering.

- 8) The delimitation committee has also ignored the distribution criteria of population and area in District Naushahro Feroze. The population and area critieria in the proposal given by the petitioner also suits to the principles of delimitation laid down in section 20 of the election act 2017.
- 9) That the preliminary delimitation has been done without considering the important facts of road networking/communication system, boundaries and public convenience which is against the basic principles of the delimitation and also against the law.
- 10) That the law requires the delimitation committee to start delimitation from the northern end of the district but in the instant matter the delimitation committee in utter disregard of the law started delimitation from the western side which speaks volumes of the committee malatide intentions and to disenfranchise the petitioner from contesting in free and fair elections. By doing the said illegal act they not only violated the law but also disregarded the administrative boundaries, historic significance and public convenience.
- 11) That preliminary delimitation has been done in total disregard of the rules for delimitation framed by the honourable election commission of Pakistan firstly the PS 33 was the first constituency was not delimited from the norther end rather from west which is in violation of the commission rules. Furthermore, PS 35 has been delimited from east to west rather than clockwise i.e east to south in contravention of the law and rules framed by the commission itself for the reasons best known to the delimitation committee but the selectiveness and giving undue advantage to particular political party is floating on the record.
- 12) That the preliminary delimitation failed to appreciate that there is no road under provincial highway or direct route between bhiria city to behlani road under PS-34 and in order to reach each other it requires almost 40 kilo meters as evident from the certificate issued by the executive engineer highway division. Further, the only direct route between them is from halani therefore, taking out behlani road from PS-33 is without any substance rather violative of the Section 20 of the 2017 Act read with rules of 2017. (Copy of the certificate is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure R/4)
- 13) It is submitted that PS -33 constituency consists of Halani however, the delimitation has been done in such manner that even the police station of halani has been excluded from PS 33 and as per preliminary delimitation falls in the PS-

34 constituency which speaks volumes of the irregular and illegal delimitation conducted by the delimitation committee.

- 14) That the main hospital of halani has also been excluded from PS 33 constituency which consist halani town committee hence, the hospital of town committee halani being placed in PS 34 is beyond understanding. Further, the deh nayabad which is part of halani city has also been placed in PS 34.
- 15) In view of the foregoing, it is submitted that Article 222 of the constitution provides that parliament may by law provide for, (a) the allocation of seats in the National Assembly as required under Article 51 (3) and (4) of the constitution, and (b) the delimitation of constituencies by the Election Commission of Pakistan. It is thus, constitutional obligation of this Honourable Commission to delimit the constituencies in accordance with law. Now, section 17 of the Election Act, 2017 provides that "Election Commission shall delimit the constituencies after every census officially published."
- 16) To delimit a constituency, the broader principles have been summarized in Section 20 of the Election Act, 2017 that as far as practicable, be delimited having regard to the (i) distribution of population in geographically compact areas, (ii) physical features, (iii) existing boundaries of administrative units, (iv) facilities of communication and public convenience and (v) other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity in the creation of constituencies. It has also been provided that "as far as possible, variation in population of constituencies of assembly shall not ordinarily exceed ten percent."
- 17) Now according to the preliminary report on proposed constituencies issued by this Honourable Commission, province of Sindh has been divided into 130 territorial constituencies on the census of 2017. The quota per seat in respect of each provincial assembly seat has been determined in relation to Sindh as under:

Total Population of Sindh: 47,893,244

Total PA Seats of Sindh: 130

Quota Per Seat:47,893,233/130 = 368,410

18) Based on the aforesaid population and seat quota with a variation of about 10% as provided in section 20 of the Election Act, 2017, four seats, now proposed for



District Naushahro Feroze out of the 130 seats allocated to the entire province of Sindh, have been drawn up as per the preliminary delimitation are as under:

- 1) PS-33, Naushahro Feroze I (Population, 392,795)
- 2) PS-34, Naushahro Feroze II (Population, 396,214)
- 3) PS-35, Naushahro Feroze III (Population, 429,980)
- 4) PS-36, Naushahro Feroze IV (Population, 393,384)
- 19) It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that PS-33 as suggested by the petitioner and MAP whereof attached herein shall be finalized by the Honourable Commission as this suggested constituency is better than the proposed constituency of PS 33 and as per the requirements of the election act 2017 read with rules and the constitution of the Islamic republic of Pakistan 1973. In the instant proposal population of the PS-33 constituency would be 403,613. (Copy of the proposed delimitation is annexed herewith alongwith map and marked as Annexure R/
- 20) The total population as referred in the preliminary delimitation of the constituencies and proposed constituencies is 16,12,373 that is the population of the district Naushahro Feroze. This would offer effective proportional representations to the people of the area. As an easy reference, a suggested map of all constituencies PS-33 (Naushahro Feroze I); PS-34 (Naushahro Feroze II); PS-35 (Naushahro Feroze III) and PS 36 (Naushahro Feroze IV) is annexed with the representation. Attention is invited thereto, which would keep the area compact and all major talukas intact with headquarters in their respective constituencies.
- 21) It is submitted that it is settled law and international practice in delimitation of the constituencies that "totality of circumstances" to be taken into account also known or called as "redistricting standard" Accordingly, in view of the totality of circumstances standard, the best presentation is what has been suggested through this representation. It may be added that, inter alia, it is the constitutional right of the general public of the area under Article 17 to have "real representatives". In case, the proposed constituencies are not reviewed altered and modified as suggested, the rights and interests of the people of the area would be adversely affected and prejudiced. This would not be warranted in law. Hence, this presentation before the Honourable Commission of Pakistan for directions as suggested hereinabove.

22) That the petitioner seeks indulgence of the Honourable Commission to urge more grounds from the record at the time of hearing of this representation.

PRAYER

The Petitioners, therefore, respectfully, pray that this Honorable Court be pleased to allow this representation and to further:

- allow the titled representation and finalize, inter alia, PS-33 (Naushahro Feroze I); PS-34 (Naushahro Feroze II); PS-35 (Naushahro Feroze III) and PS-36 (Naushahro Feroze IV) as proposed through instant representation and may further be pleased to make all appropriate adjustment, amendment, alteration and modification to the proposed constituency in the interest of justice.
- b) Grant any other relief, additional and or moulded as this Honorable Commission may deem fit, proper and or necessary in the circumstances of the case.



I, Syed Abrar Ali Shah S/o Syed Muhammad Aqil Shah, applicant, do hereby appoint and constitute **Barrister Waleed Khanzada**, Advocate to appear and act for me as my Advocate in the above matter.

- 1. To act, appear and plead in the matter mentioned above, and to withdraw or compromise the said matter or to submit to arbitration any difference or disputes that shall arise touching or in any matter relating to the said matter and to receive money and grant receipts therefore, and to do all other acts and things which may be necessary to do done for the progress and the course of the prosecution of the said matter.
- 2. To draft, sign file all necessary pleadings, applications affidavits or documents as shall be deemed necessary or advisable for the prosecution of the said matter at all its stages.
- 3. To associate any other legal practitioner, authorizing him to exercise the power and authorities hereby conferred on the advocate, whenever he may think fit to do so.
- 4. I/we also authorize the said advocates to withdraw and to receive on my/our behalf all sums and amounts deposited on my/our account in the above noted matter and /or refer the above matter to arbitration or to compromise or to withdraw the same.
