



PETITION OF OBJECTIONS

Respected Sir,

The petitioners, above-named, most respectfully and very humbly, submit as under:-


- 1. That the petitioners are the residents and voters of PS-49 Mirpurkhas-II have gone through the fresh Delimitation of the Constituencies as announced by the Election Commission which according to Election Commission is described in annexed schedule.
- 2. That the Delimitation as marked by the Election Commission is not in accordance with the policy of Election Commission in respect of Geographical Compactness of a Constituency. Whatever Delimitation made by the Election Commission in respect of PS-48 & PS-49 is not correct in respect of Geographical Boundaries as in PS-48 the STC of Mirwah which is a part and parcel of Taluka Shuja'abad has been bifurcated and included in PS-49, whereas Taluka Mirpurkhas and STC Mirwah both are Urban Population and





in order to benefit one of the political party the same population has been divided into two PS i.e. 48 & 49 as shown in the map requires reconsideration as because STC Jhalori has been included in PS-48, whereas the total population of Jhalori consists upon Rural Areas which is also not geographical compact and homogeneous and it also not serve the people in respect of facilities and the public utilities.

- 3. That the above objection shows that the Election Commission has not properly demarcated the two P.S. as they are not geographically and naturally adjacent nor they are in accordance with the Section 20 of Law of Delimitation and by doing so the administrative units, division of population, facilities of transportation, hospitals and police station all may be disturbed, which resulted into disturbance in the general public, hence the request is made.
- 4. That the proposal to exclude STC Jhalori from PS-48 and to shift STC Jhalori to PS-49 with a population of 60680 and whereas the inclusion of STC Mirwah having population of 52763, so this amendment shall not affect the






population ratio of both PS but it would create harmony among the people and create peace and rest in all sections of population, such demarcation creates harmony and brother-hood within the different population having different languages and the same is in accordance with the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan, as reported in PLD 2011 Supreme Court 997 that the demarcation shall not be for the benefit of any political party but based on smooth population and multi-linguistic areas. The relevant portion of the judgment is reproduced as under:-

"Further observe that to avoid political polarization and to break the style of ethnic strife and turn war, boundaries of administrative units like police stations, revenue estates, etc., ought to be altered so that the members of different communities may live together in peace and harmony, instead of allowing various groups to claim that particular areas belong to them and declaring certain areas as NO GO areas under their fearful influence. Subsequent thereto, on similar considerations, in view of relevant laws, delimitation of different constituencies has also to be undertaken with the same object and purpose, particularly to make Karachi, which is the hub of economic and commercial activities and also the face of Pakistan, a peaceful city in the near future. The Election Commission of Pakistan may also initiate the process of its own in this behalf."


Proposal as made above is annexed as schedule.





- 5. That the majority of Urdu Speaking population is residing with the people of other languages but the proposed setup creating ethnic distribution.
- 6. That socially and economically STC Mirwah is fully attached and part & parcel of Taluka Mirpurkhas and City of Mirpurkhas, as the population having blood relation, social relation, economic and brother-hood, as TC Mirwah was a Town Committee since 1986 and administered by the Administrator of Mirpurkhas in all practical purposes till todate. The salaries and pensions are also controlled by the District Mirpurkhas, therefore, for all practical purposes STC Mirwah is adjacent to Taluka Mirpurkhas and it is better to include the said two entities in one PS otherwise break the system of administration, social relation and harmony including business.

So in order to create harmony among the different languages and maintaining geographical setup, undersigned is proposing the Delimitation of the above referred constituencies as per annexed schedule. Therefore, you are requested that by considering all the above facts, geographical conditions and law of demarcation, the demarcation of PS-103 & 104 may be





amended in such a way, as proposed in the annexed schedule for which we shall be very grateful.
