SUBJECT: REPRESENTATION REGARDING RELOCATION OF DEH DARO QUBI, DEH MAREJE, DEH NAHIKE, TALUKA TANDO ALLAHYAR - OBJECTION REGARDING THE DE-LIMITATION OF PS-60 (OLD PS-51)

Sir,

We the undersigned residents of DehDaroQubi, DehMareji and DehNaiki, TalukaTandoAllahyar, District TandoAllahyar beg to submit the representation with regard to objections against the de-limitation of constituency Ps-51 (New PS-60) on the following amongst other ground.

1. That DehDaroQubi along with other DehMareji and DehNaiki are situated in Tapa Additional TandoAllahyar since the independence.
2. That DehdaroQubi is a part and parcel of TalukaTandoAllahyar, as it is just adjacent to TandoAllahyar Town, thus having geographical compactness and contiguity with TandoAllahyar Town.
3. That due to it's geographical compactness and contiguity it has always remained within the constituency PS-51, as a part and parcel thereof.
4. That in new proposal for de-limitation, DehDaroQubi has been amalgamated and included in New PS-61 (previously PS-52).
5. That the inclusion of DehDaroQubi in PS-61 is bound to cause enormous inconvenience and great hardship to the residents of the Deh as the central place/Head Quarter is at the distance of 30 Kms as against the distance of 2/3 Kms viz from TandoAllahyar.
6. That for the most principle of convenience of the people will be seriously jeopardized by the above proposal of de-limitation, which is lacking in geographical compactness and communication.
7. That it will further cause hardship and inconvenience on account of administrative setup as the DehDaroQubi falls within the administrative set up of TandoAllahyar Taluka whereas PS-61 (Old PS-52) consist of different Talukaviz Taluka Chamber.
8. That the proposed de-limitation is against the universally accepted principles which require distribution of population in geographically compact areas, physical features, existing boundaries of administrative unit (viz. Tapa and TalukaTandoAllahyar) facilities of communication and [public convenience and other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity in the creation of constituencies.


9. That it may not be out of place to respectfully submit that the State Pakistan has ratified the international covenant on civil and political rights and the main principles of which are equality of vote, which requires convenience of voters to ensure fairness of franchise.
10. That the new proposal of de-limitation if approved is obviously to harm the fairness of election process thus detrimental to the entire system.
11. That it will be in the larger public interest and to ensure the fairness of the process that Deh Daro Qubi Tapa and Taluka Tando Allahyar may be excluded from the new proposal (of adding/including in PS-61) and be allowed to continue/remain in the constituency PS-60 Tando Allahyar as it is geographically compact and administratively supported.
12. Deh Naiki and Deh Mareji were de-limited in 2015 during local government election whose parts have already been included in Municipal Committee Tando Allahyar and its boundaries also touching the Municipal Committee. The same also may be included in PS-60 and excluded from PS-61.

The prayer is made in the interest of justice.
