**REPRESENTATION IN RESPECT OF THE DELIMITATION OF
THE CONSTITUENCY PS-62, PS-63, PS-64, PS-65, PS-66 HYDERABAD &
NA-225, NA-226 & NA-227 HYDERABAD PROPOSED IN THE
PRELIMINARY REPORT.**

Respectfully Sheweth,

1. That, the Objector is a registered voter of the Constituency PS-62, who is aggrieved by the delimitation of this constituency proposed in the preliminary report. In order to substantiate this fact his Copy of CNIC and Certificate of Voter is attached with this Memorandum. **Annexure-A**
2. That, it is Constitutional Obligation of the Election Commission of Pakistan to ensure free and fair polls in the Country. For achieving this object fair and transparent delimitation is indispensable. Election Commission of Pakistan is duty bound to provide the voters of Constituency such an environment or process where they can exercise their right to vote in a free and convenient manner.
3. That, the preliminary report relating to delimitation suggests that the Demarcation of Boundaries of electoral Constituency of PS-62 is faulty and will disenfranchise a great number of voters.
4. That, according to fresh delimitation's preliminary report the boundaries of PS-62 are badly disturbed and right of public

convenient and vote not kept in view, which creates the high suspicious the ulterior motives from the part of ruling party.

5. That, Tapedar Circles STC of Taluka Hyderabad (Rural), (i) STC-Additional-Kathri (ii) STC-Kathri (iii) STC-Hatri an inconvenient population of 74375 is excluded from PS-63 and with Ulterior Motives same Population is included in PS-62, meanwhile the P-S 62 is constituted with urban population and the said Supervisory Tapedari Circles are rural population and very much away from the PS- 62 Urban area. In addition to it, Charge No: 17 &18 of PS-62 have been excluded and merged into PS-66 Taluka Hyderabad City, and Circles Nos: 02,03 &05 of Charge No: 01 are excluded from PS-62(old P.S 47 Taluka Qasimabad) and have been included in PS-65 Taluka Latifabad. In the Map of PS-62 prepared by ECP clearly shows that exclusion of Charge No: 17 & 18 is looking as a Wall to separate the General Population into two pieces, which geographically is injustice with voters of PS-62.

Map showing boundaries of District Hyderabad prepared by ECP is annexed here with as **Annexure-B**.

6. That, infrastructure of PS-62 shall badly affect in case of the wrong and non physibile delimitation of the Constituency. Civic facilities like Water Sewerage, Sanitation and Development of general public shall be frustrated and the people would face great deal of difficulties. The convenience of the people and their basic rights and facilities has not been taken care by the ECP/Delimitation Authorities.
