PETITION OF OBJECTIONS

The petitioner, above-named, most respectfully and very humbly submit as under:-

1. That the petitioner is the resident of PS-64 and his address mentioned in the title of the petition, so he is directly aggrieved by the new Delimitation of the Constituencies as announced by the Election Commission.

2. That the Delimitation Act provides delimitation of constituencies in accordance with nature of distribution of population in geographically compact areas and the same is provided under Section-9 and for ready reference, the same is reproduced as under:-

"[9. Principles of delimitation.—All constituencies for general seats shall, as far as practicable, be delimited having regard to the distribution of population in geographically compact areas, existing boundaries of administrative units, facilities of communication and public convenience and other cognate factors to ensure homogeneity in the creation of constituencies.

Provided that for the purpose of delimiting constituencies for the general seats for the Federal Administered Tribal Areas two or more separate areas may be grouped into one constituency.

(2) As far as may be the constituencies for election to the same Assembly shall be equal among themselves in population.]"

3. That the Delimitation of the Constituencies as proposed by the Election Commission in respect of PS-64 and 65 which shows that the same are not in accordance with the provisions of Section-9 i.e. geographically not compact and for one part of the constituencies as in the case of 64 & 65 and it is proposed that charge-19 of District Code 359 of PS-64 may be excluded from PS-64 and charge-12 with District Code 35912 has to be included because the area of District Code 361 and the people of such area would face problem to go over there which may result into low turnout and because there is no natural boundary and the area does not included into Taluka Committee, therefore, the same shall be inserted and deleted as proposed.

4. That some part of charge-1 may also be included in the said PS-64, so the compactness of PS and ratio of population shall maintain and no hue and cry can be raised at any time. Therefore, the petitioner has framed proposal which are annexed with this petition.

In view of the above, it is therefore prayed that draft proposals/ objections shall be considered and the Delimitation of the Constituencies shall be re-checked and re-defined as per proposals made by the petitioner.
