Subject: FILING OF STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS BY THE POLITICAL PARTIES.

Islamabad, the 08<sup>th</sup> September, 2016. - The Election Commission of Pakistan has time and again drawn attention of Political Parties to submit their statements of party accounts as per provisions of Section-13 of the Political Parties Order, 2002, which provides that every political party shall submit to the Election Commission, within 60 days from the close of each financial year, a consolidated statement of accounts of the party, duly audited by a Chartered Accountant, for which the last date was August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2016,

- 2. In view of the above, the candidates of all those political parties who have not submitted their annual party account statement and have also failed to conduct their intra-party election as per requirement of Section-12 of Political Parties Order 2002, shall not be allowed to participate in the election on the election symbol already allotted to their respective political parties.
- 3. This decision is to take immediate effect. All the Returning Officers of the ensuing bye-elections are directed to implement the decision of the Commission in letter and spirit.
