DURING BYE ELECTIONS-2024

- i. Perform their duties in accordance with role of Armed Forces defined in Article 245 of the Constitution of Pakistan, the law and within the confines of mandate assigned to Armed Forces to assist Election Commission of Pakistan in conduct of Bye Elections / Re-Poll by deploying/ providing:-
- Secure environment for easy and secure access of voters to Polling Station. Wherein, Police will be 1st tier responders while Civil Armed Forces / Armed Forces as 2nd and 3rd tier responders, respectively.
 - Deploying outside selected Most Sensitive Polling Stations.
 - Security of printing presses during printing of Ballot Papers.
 - Security during transportation of Ballot Papers from Printing Presses to the office of District Returning Officers.
 - Security, during transportation of election material from Offices of Returning Officers to Polling Stations and back, after completion of Polling and counting.
