Subject:- **ANNOUNCEMENT OF SCHEDULE TO CONDUCT LOCAL GOVERNMENT 6TH BYE-ELECTIONS TO FILL IN THE VACANT SEATS OF LOCAL COUNCILS IN KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA PROVINCE.**

No.F.32(2)/2016-LGE-KPK(Vol-II)(2):- In exercise of the powers conferred upon it under Article 140A of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, sub-section (1) of Section-75 & Section-81 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Local Government Act, 2013 read with sub-rule (1) of Rule-13 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Local Councils (Conduct of Elections) Rules, 2014 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Election Commission of Pakistan hereby issues schedule for Local Government 6th Bye-Election to fill in the vacant seats i.e. *General, Woman, Youth and Peasant/ Worker* in various Village/ Neighbourhood Councils of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province and calls upon the electors of the councils concerned to elect their representatives from the attached list of local government institutions:

2. With a view to ensure that bye-election to the Local Government are conducted honestly, justly, fairly and in accordance with law and to ensure that the corrupt practices are guarded against, the Election Commission of Pakistan directs that:-




- a. All executive Authorities in the Federation and in the Provinces shall not use State Resources in Local Government bye-elections calculated to influence the elections in favour of a particular candidate or a political party.
- b. If any person in government service misuses his official position in any manner in order to influence results of elections, he shall be liable to be proceeded against under Section 100 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Local Government Act, 2013.
- c. No Transfers / postings of the civil servants shall be made after the issuance of Schedule of Local Government Bye-Elections without prior approval of the Commission till the publication of election results.
- d. After the issuance of Election Schedule, the Prime Minister, Governor, Chief Minister, Speaker, Deputy Speaker, Federal and Provincial Ministers, Advisors to the Prime Minister or Chief Minister, District or Tehsil Nazim & Naib Nazim or any other holder of public office will not visit the area of any local council to announce any development scheme or to canvass or campaign for any candidate or any political party.
- e. No Deputy Commissioner shall perform protocol duty with the Prime Minister, Chief Minister, Speaker, Deputy Speaker, Federal Ministers State Ministers, Provincial Ministers, Advisors to the Prime Ministers and Chief Minister or any person on their behalf till conclusion of the electoral process.
- f. Any holder of public office, who is found to have violated any provision of Election Laws or the instructions issued by the Election Commission, shall be proceeded against as mandated in law.

Note: The offices of the Election Commission as well as the offices of District Returning Officers and Returning Officers shall remain open on all public holidays during the schedule period.

All electoral activities mentioned in the aforesaid schedule shall be undertaken during office hours (08:00 a.m. to 04:00 p.m.) and the said timing will also be followed on public holidays fixed for any electoral activity of the schedule.




