Furthermore, there shall be a vigilant monitoring teams reporting on each reported areas. It is thus decided that the entire polling staff shall remain the same. Election Commission of Pakistan has appointed five Officers is monitored for said election PS-114 Karachi and they would the reporting directly to Election Commission of Pakistan Islamabad throughout polling process. Election Commission of Pakistan is fully monitoring every activity of polling process in PS-114 and is committed to conduct, free, fair and impartial Election.
