The Election Commission of Pakistan has drawn attention of Contesting Candidates for Bye-Election in Nation Assembly of Pakistan from constituency No. NA-260 Quetta-Cum-Ghagai-Cum-Nushki (Old Quetta-Cum-Ghagai-Mustung), to the provision of Section 84 of the Representation of the People Act, 1976, which provide that no person shall convene, hold or attend any Public Meeting and no person shall promote or join in any procession within the areas of the Constituency during a period of forty.-eight hours ending at midnight following the conclusion of the Poll for an election in that Constituency. Any person who contravenes this provision of law shall be punishable with rigorous imprisonment for a term, which may extend to six months or with fine, which may extend to one thousand rupees or with both.

1. Accordingly, the election campaign for Bye-Election in aforesaid constituency shall come to an end with effect from the <u>midnight falling</u> <u>between the 13th and 14 July, 2017.</u> The Political Parties and the candidates are requested to follow the provisions of law and exercise self-restraint so that the Poll is held in an orderly and peaceful manner on the **15th July, 2017.**
