No.F.8(11)/2016-LGE(C)(Vol-III).— Consequent upon the disqualification of General Member, Ward No.7 of Cantonment Board Multan by the learned Election Tribunal, Multan and resignation tendered by General Member, Ward No.10 of Cantonment Board Multan and pursuant to the provisions of Article 140A of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, provisions of Section 72 of the Cantonments Ordinance, 2002 read with Rules 8, 9 & 14 of the Cantonments Local Government (Election) Rules, 2015 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Election Commission of Pakistan hereby issues the Schedule for conduct of Bye-Elections to fill the vacant seats of General Members in respect of Wards of Cantonment Board Multan, calls upon the electorates of such Wards to elect their representatives and specifies in relation thereto the following dates:

- 2. With a view to ensure that elections to the Cantonment Boards are conducted honestly, justly, fairly and in accordance with law and to ensure that the corrupt practices are guarded against, the Election Commission of Pakistan directs that:
 - (i) All Executive Authorities in the Federation and in the Provinces shall not use State Resources in Elections to the Cantonment Boards calculated to influence the elections in favour of a particular candidate.
 - (ii) If any person in Government Service misuses his official position in any manner in order to influence results of the elections, he shall be liable to be proceeded against under Section 86 of the Cantonments Ordinance, 2002;
 - (iii) No transfers/postings of the civil servants appointed by Election Commission for conduct of Cantonment Boards Elections shall be made after the issuance of Election Schedule without prior approval of the Commission till the publication of election results;
 - (iv) After the issuance of Election Schedule, the Prime Minister, Governors, Chief Ministers, Chairman Senate, Deputy Chairman Senate, Speakers of Assemblies, Deputy Speakers of Assemblies, Federal and Provincial Ministers, Advisors to the Prime Minister or Chief Ministers or any other holder of public office will not visit the area of any Cantonment Board to announce any development package or to canvass or campaign for any candidate or any political party.
 - (v) Any holder of public office, who is found to have violated any provision of the applicable Election Law or the instructions issued by the Election Commission, shall be proceeded against as mandated in law.
 - (vi) No leave of the civil servant will be granted after the issuance of Election Schedule of the Local Government Election without prior approval of the Commission till the publication of election results. In case leave has already been sanctioned, the officer will not relinquish his charge without the approval of the Hon'ble Commission.
- **Note**: (i) The concerned offices of the Election Commission as well as the offices of Returning Officers shall remain open on all public holidays during the schedule period fixed for any electoral activity.
 - (ii) All electoral activities mentioned in the aforesaid schedule except for those for which time is fixed in the Rules, shall be undertaken during office hours (08:00 A.M. to 04:00 P.M.) and the said timing will also be followed on public holidays fixed for any electoral activity of the schedule.
 - (iii) Poling hours shall be from 08:00 A.M. to 04:00 P.M.
