ELECTION SCHEDULE FOR THE CONDUCT OF FRESH ELECTION TO THE SEATS OF CHAIRMAN & VICE CHAIRMAN, DISTRICT COUNCIL, KHUSHAB

No.F.4(20)/2016-LGE(P)(Vol-III):— Pursuant to the Judgment dated 08.05.2018 passed by the August Supreme Court of Pakistan in Civil Appeal No.631 of 2018 titled "Malik Ameer Haider Sangha and others Vs. Mrs. Sumaira Malik and others", provisions of Article 140A of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, sub-section (3) of Section 14 of the Punjab Local Government Act, 2013 read with Rules 40 & 42 of the Punjab Local Governments (Conduct of Elections) Rules, 2013 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, Election Commission of Pakistan hereby issues the Schedule for filling up the seats of Chairman & Vice Chairman of District Council, Khushab, calls upon the representatives of concerned District Council to elect such Chairmen/Vice Chairman and specifies in relation thereto, the following dates:

- 2. With a view to ensure that election to the Local Government is conducted in accordance with the provisions of Article 218(3) of the Constitution, the Election Commission of Pakistan directs that:
  - a. All Executive Authorities in the Federation and in the Provinces shall not use State Resources in Local Government Bye-Election calculated to influence the election in favor of a particular candidate or a political party.
  - b. If any person in government service misuses his official position in any manner in order to influence results of election, he shall be liable to be proceeded against under Section 60 of the Punjab Local Government Act, 2013.

- c. No transfers / postings of the civil servants shall be made after the issuance of Election Schedule of the Local Government / Bye-Election without prior approval of the Commission till the publication of election results.
- d. No leave of the civil servant will be granted after the issuance of Election Schedule of the Local Government Election without prior approval of the Commission till the publication of election results. In case leave has already been sanctioned, the officer will not relinquish his charge without the approval of the Hon'ble Commission.
- e. After the issuance of Election Schedule, the President, Prime Minister, Chairman/Deputy Chairman Senate, Speaker, Deputy Speaker, Federal Ministers, Ministers of State, Advisors to the Prime Minister another Public office holder shall neither openly nor in secret give any subscription or donation or make promises for giving such subscription or donation to any institution, nor shall inaugurate, commit to undertake or announce any development project therein for the advancement of the campaign of a candidate of his choice and thereby influence the results of election.
- f. No Deputy Commissioner/District Coordination Officer shall perform protocol duty with the Prime Minister, Chief Minister, Speaker, Deputy Speaker, Federal Ministers, State Ministers, Provincial Ministers, Advisors to the Prime Minister and Chief Minister or any person on their behalf till conclusion of the electoral process.
- g. Any holder of public office, who is found to have violated any provision of election laws or the instructions issued by the Election Commission, shall be proceeded against as mandated in law.
- h. The poll shall be taken from 09:00 AM to 02:00 PM without any break.
- **Note:** (i) The concerned offices of the Election Commission as well as the offices of District Returning Officer and Returning Officer shall remain open on all public holidays during the schedule period in case any activity is involved.
- (ii) All electoral activities mentioned in the aforesaid schedule shall be undertaken during office hours and the said timing will also be followed on public holidays fixed for any electoral activity of the schedule.
- (iii) ECP's instructions issued from time to time for conduct of Local Government Elections, as far as practicable, shall be followed for conduct of election.
