## **ELECTION COMMISSION OF PAKISTAN**

## NOTIFICATION

Islamabad, the 14th June, 2018

No.F.2(3)/2018-Cord.- WHEREAS, the Election Commission of Pakistan directed on 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2018:-

- a. That all kinds of recruitments in any Ministry, Division, Department or Institution of the Federal Government or any Department or Institution of any Provincial and Local governments are banned forthwith, except recruitments by the Federal or a Provincial Public Service Commission and those where test/interviews have already been conducted by 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018.
- b. That all development schemes which have been approved with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018 like installation of gas pipelines, supply of electricity, roads carpeting, water supply schemes etc. Shall not be executed by the Federal/Provincial/local governments authorities. Moreover, the Federal Government, the Provincial Governments and the Local Government shall not issue tenders of such schemes till conclusion of General elections, 2018.
- c. That diversion of funds already allocated to various development projects in the country is banned forthwith and the spending of funds so diverted shall stand frozen forthwith.

WHEREAS the term of the National Assembly and all Provincial Assemblies expired by 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2018 and the Care-Taker Governments have been established at Federal as well as Provincial level.

Now therefore in exercise of its powers conferred on under Article 218(3) of the Constitution read with Section 4, 5 and 8(c) of the Elections Act, 2017 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Election Commission of Pakistan directs that:

a. The ban imposed on recruitments is withdrawn forthwith.

Provided that care taker governments shall not make promotions or major appointments of public officials but may make acting or short term appointments in public interest.
