الیکشن کمیشن نے چیف منسٹر خیبر پختونخواہ جناب سہیل آفریدی کے حویلیاں جلسے کے خطاب کے دوران دیئے گئے بیان جس میں انہوں نے ضلعی انتظامیہ، پولیس اور الیکشن میں تعینات عملہ کو دھمکایا اور جلسے میں موجود پبلک اور عمومی طور پر عوام کو آکسانے پر نوٹس لیا ہے، اس موقع پر ان کے ساتھ ایک مفروہ مجرم بھی کھڑا تھا جس کی زوجہ الیکشن میں حصہ لے رہی ہیں۔ صوبے کے چیف ایگزیکٹو کے اس غیر ذمہ دارانہ اور رویہ کی وجہ سے نہ صرف این اے 18 ہری پور میں پُر امن ضمنی انتخاب کا انعقاد مشکل ہو گیا ہے، بلکہ ضلعی انتظامیہ، پولیس اور الیکشن ڈیوٹی پر مامور عملہ اور ووٹروں کی جان کو بھی خطرہ لاحق ہوا ہے۔ کمیشن نے حالات کی نزاکت کو سامنے رکھتے ہوئے صوبائی الیکشن کمشنر خیبر پختونخوا کو حکم دیا کہ وہ اس سلسلے میں فوری طور پر چیف سیکرٹری اور آئی جی سے میٹنگ کریں اور ضروری حفاظتی اقدامات کرنے کے بعد اپنی رپورٹ الیکشن کمیشن کو پیش کریں۔

الیکشن کمیشن نے معاملے کی سنگینی کو مد نظر رکھتے ہوئے چیف منسٹر خیبر پختونخواہ سہیل آفریدی اور امیدوار مسماۃ شہرناز عمر ایوب کو الیکشن ایکٹ 2017ء اور ضابطہ اخلاق کی خلاف ورزی پر کل مورخہ 21 نومبر 2025ء کو طلب کرتے ہوئے نوٹس جاری کر دیے ہیں۔

مزید یہ بھی فیصلہ کیا کہ فوری طور پر سیکرٹری وزارت داخلہ کو چٹھی ارسال کی جائے کہ حلقہ میں وفاقی سیکورٹی اداروں کی مدد سے فول پروف سیکورٹی انتظامات کیئے جائیں، تاکہ ڈسٹرکٹ ریٹرننگ آفیسر، ریٹرننگ، دیگر انتخابی اہلکاروں، ووٹروں اور پبلک کے تحفظ کو یقینی بنایا جاسکے۔ اور Presiding Officers کی پولنگ سٹیشنز کی طرف اور الیکشن کے بعد RO آفس کی طرف اُنکی اور الیکشن میٹریل کی Movement کو تحفظ دیا جاسکے۔

کمیشن نے یہ بھی فیصلہ کیا کہ ضمنی انتخابات کے دوران کسی فرد، شخصیت یا پبلک آفس ہولڈر نے الیکشن کے پُر امن انعقاد میں مداخلت یا خلل ڈالنے کی کوشش کی تو اُنکے خلاف سخت قانونی کارروائی عمل میں لائے جائے گی۔ صوبائی الیکشن کمشنر پنجاب کو بھی اسی طرح ہدایات جاری کر دی گئی ہیں کہ اگر فیڈرل یا صوبائی حکومت کا کوئی بھی عہدیدار ضابطہ اخلاق کی خلاف ورزی کرے یا ضمنی الیکشن کو Influence کرنے کی کوشش کرے تو آئین اور قانون کے مطابق سخت سے سخت کارروائی کی جائے۔

Subject: VIOLATION OF CODE OF CONDUCT BY CHIEF MINISTER KPK.

Through media and our monitoring unit reports, it was informed that the Chief Minister, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa participated in a public meeting / Jalsa as a part of the election campaign of Mst. Shehar Naz Omar Ayub Khan in NA-18 Haripur, Tehsil Havelian yesterday evening and delivered a provocative speech against public functionaries including district management, police and election officials (DRO/RO) regarding the upcoming bye-election. The speech is in direct contravention of Section 170 of the Elections Act, 2017 and Clauses 10 & 18 of the Code of Conduct issued by the Election Commission. These clauses categorically forbid Chief Ministers from taking part in any election campaign and further prohibits incitement of the public to violence and / or intimidation of public officials and voters by use of such language.

2. The Provincial Election Commissioner, KP has already been instructed to hold a meeting with you and Inspector General of Police, KP along with other relevant officers today at 11:30 a.m. to assess the situation created as a result of this matter.

3. It is requested that the meeting **must be personally attended** by the Head of Provincial Administration (Chief Secretary) as well as the Head of Police (IG, KP). A detailed report of the proceedings and recommendations shall be forwarded by the PEC, KP to the Hon'ble Election Commission for further action.

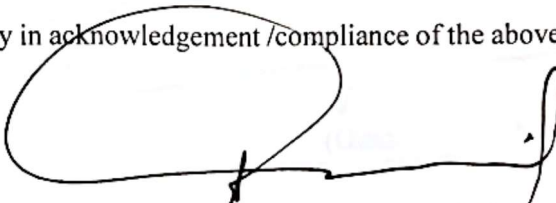
I would like to draw your attention to an urgent matter that was reported today through media reports and Monitoring Wing of this Commission's Secretariat that around 03.00 p.m. Mr. Sohail Khan Afridi, Chief Minister, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province addressed a public rally at Havelian in which he used provocative language and clearly threatened public officials such as district administration, the police officers/officials and election officials engaged in connection with bye-election in the constituency NA-18 Haripur, to be held on 23rd November, 2025. Regrettably, he used offensive language, which amounts to harassing and unduly influencing them which may prevent them from effective performance of their duties (Copy of transcript of speech is enclosed). The Commission is of the view that said act of the Chief Executive of the Province has created live threats to the election officials and specially the voters. Further, a fugitive was also accompanying the Chief Minister and the concerned authorities have not taken any action against him.

2. You are, therefore, requested to take immediate notice of this situation and deploy Civil Armed Forces/Pakistan Army to allow the peaceful conduct of polling on 23rd November, 2025 in the constituency and also to take other appropriate measures to protect the lives of Election Officials, voters and public at large during the said elections.

3. A response be conveyed urgently in acknowledgement/compliance of the above as per orders of the Hon'ble Commission.

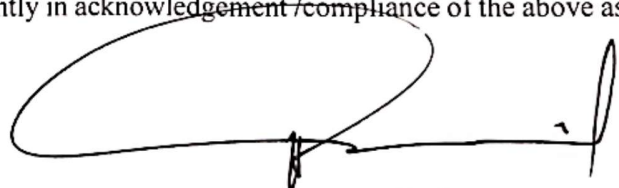
