

# ELECTION COMMISSION OF PAKISTAN

## PRESS RELEASE

**Islamabad the 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2018:** As per schedule issued today by the Election Commission, the prospective candidates for Election to the office of the President of Pakistan can file their Nomination Papers on 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 (upto 12:00 noon) before the following Presiding Officers appointed for that Election:

2. The Nomination Forms can be obtained from the offices of above mentioned Presiding Officers as well as from the following offices during office hours:

- (4) Office of the Provincial Election Commissioner, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Bungalow No.11-A, Michini Road, Peshawar Cantt. Peshawar.
- (5) Office of the Provincial Election Commissioner, Balochistan, Barginza Villa Street No.01, Zargoan Road, Quetta.

3. The candidates for Presidential Elections will have to submit, alongwith their Nomination Papers, the original extract from the Electoral Rolls prepared for General Elections, 2018 issued/signed by the Registration Officer/District Election Commissioner concerned.

4. In this connection attention of the candidates is drawn towards the provisions of paragraph 4 of Second Schedule to the Constitution of Pakistan and Rule 3(2) of the Presidential Election Rules, 1988, which are reproduced hereunder:

**Paragraph 4 of Second Schedule of the Constitution.**

At any time before noon on the day fixed for nomination any member of the Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) or of a Provincial Assembly may nominate for election as President a person qualified for election as President by delivering to the Presiding Officer a nomination paper, signed by himself as proposer and by another member of the Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) or, as the case may be Assembly as Secunder, together with a statement signed by the person nominated that he consents to the nomination.

**Rule 3(2) of the President Election Rules, 1988.**

Every nomination paper shall be accompanied by an attested copy of the extract from the electoral roll in which the person nominated is enrolled as a voter and attested copies of the identity cards of the proposer and the seconder issued by the Senate Secretariat, National Assembly Secretariat or, as the case may be, Provincial Assembly Secretariat.

5. It is clarified that the Proposer and Secunder of the candidates should be Parliamentarian or a Member of any of the Provincial Assembly. The Proposer/Secunder will have to produce his/her Identity Card issued by National/ Provincial Assembly Secretariat to prove his/her identity before the Returning Officer/Chief Election Commissioner at the time of Scrutiny of Nomination Papers, which will be held on 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 10:00 AM by the Hon'ble Chief Election Commissioner for Election to the office of the President of Pakistan.
