Article 218 (3) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan read with section 219 (6) of the Elections Act, 2017 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Election Commission of Pakistan is pleased to direct that boundaries of existing administrative units shall stand ceased forthwith and no change in the boundaries of afore mentioned administrative units shall be made till the culmination of delimitation process in the Punjab Province.
