

ELECTION COMMISSION OF PAKISTAN

PRESS RELEASE

Islamabad, 1st January, 2021:— Members of the Parliament and Provincial Assemblies were required to submit to the Election Commission by 31st December, 2020, yearly a copy of statement of assets and liabilities including assets and liabilities of their spouse (s) and dependent children as on the preceding thirtieth day of June on Form-B which is a mandatory requirement under Section 137 (1) of the Elections Act, 2017.

2. The following Members of the Senate, National Assembly and Provincial Assemblies of the Punjab, Sindh, Khyber Paktunkhwa and Balochistan who have not yet complied with afore-stated legal provision, are hereby informed through this Press Release that they submit Statements of Assets and Liabilities **till 15th January, 2021** during office hours failing which their membership shall be suspended on **16th January, 2021** by the Hon'ble Election Commission of Pakistan in accordance with Section 137 (3) of the Elections Act, 2017.
