No. F. 21(1)/2023-Elec-I- In Pursuance of Article 218 (3) of Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, it is the duty of Election Commission to organize and conduct election and to make such arrangements as are necessary to ensure that the election is conducted honestly, justly, fairly and in accordance with law and that corrupt practices are guarded against. The Election Commission, in exercise of its power under Article 220 of the Constitution and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, has requisitioned the services of Civil Armed Forces. Accordingly the Federal Government vide Ministry of Interior order no. F.No. 1/7/2018-CAF(C) dated 09th July, 2024 has authorized deployment of sufficient strength of Civil Armed Forces (Standby / Quick Reaction Force Mode only) as 2nd Tier responder for provision of general area security to assist the Election Commission of Pakistan in peaceful conduct of bye election in Provincial Assembly Constituency No. PK-22 Bajaur-IV, of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province to be held on 11th July, 2024.

2. The Election Commission of Pakistan in terms of Article 220 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan read with Section 5 and Section 193 of the Elections Act, 2017 (XXIII of 2017) hereby authorizes each designated officer in-charge of **Civil Armed Forces** (Gazetted as well as Junior Commissioned Officer) deployed for providing security as per mandate to exercise powers of Magistrate First Class for entire period of deployment i.e. 10th to 12th July, 2024 in respect of offences punishable under sections 176,177,183 and 194 of the aforesaid act and to take cognizance of any such offences under any of the clauses of subsection (1) of Section 190 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and to try any such offences in a summary way in accordance with the provisions of the said Code relating to summary trials in respect of bye election in Provincial Assembly Constituency No. PK-22 Bajaur-IV, of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province going to be held on 11th July, 2024.
