No.F.2(16)/2022-LGE-B(Vol-III)(2):- In exercise of the powers conferred upon it under Article 140(A)(2) and 219(d) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Section 219 of the Elections Act, 2017, Section 16 the of Balochistan Local Government Act-2010 read with Rule-48 of the Balochistan Local Government (Election) Rules, 2013 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Election Commission of Pakistan hereby calls upon the General Members of the Union Council No.31 of District Hub, Balochistan Province to elect the Members on Reserved Seats i.e. Women, Peasant, Worker and Non-Muslim in their respective Council and in connection therewith appoints the following dates of various activities of elections:-

^{2.} To ensure that elections are conducted honestly, justly, fairly in accordance with law and to ensure that the corrupt practices are guarded against, the Election Commission of Pakistan directs that:-

- i. If any person in Government Service misuses his official position in any manner in order to influence results of the elections, he shall be liable to be proceeded against under the Law;
- ii. After issuance of election schedule, no transfers / postings of the Officers and Officials appointed in connection with election shall be made without prior approval of the Commission till the publication of election results;
- iii. After the issuance of Election Schedule, the President, Prime Minister, Chief Minister, Governor, Speaker and Deputy Speaker of any assembly, Chairman and Deputy Chairman, of Senate, Federal and Provincial Ministers, Advisors to the Prime Minister or Chief Minister or any other holder of public office shall not visit the area of any local council to announce any development scheme or to canvass or campaign for any candidate or any political party. In case if someone is resident of the district where elections are being held he may visit the district however shall not take part in any kind of political activity.
- iv. No leave of the Officers and Officials appointed in connection with election will be granted without prior approval of the Commission till the publication of election results. In case leave has already been sanctioned, the officer will not relinquish his charge without approval of the Hon'ble Commission;
- v. Any holder of public office, who is found to have violated any provision of Election Laws or the instructions issued by the Election Commission, shall be proceeded against as mandated in law;

Note:-

- The offices of the Election Commission as well as the offices of District Returning Officers and Returning Officers shall remain open on all public holidays if any activity provided in the schedule falls on that day.
- ii. All electoral activities mentioned in the aforesaid schedule shall be undertaken during office hours and the said timing will also be followed on public holidays fixed for any electoral activity of the schedule.
- iii. The District Returning Officer, Returning Officer, Assistant Returning Officer and Appellate Authority appointed vide ECP's Notification No.F.2(14)/2022-LGE-B(Vol-I) dated 12th January, 2023 and No.F.2(6)/2022-LGE-B dated 26th January, 2023 respectively will continue to perform functions in connection with Local Government Election on reserved seats of Union Council No.31 of District Hub, Balochistan Province.
- iv. Polling Hours will be observed from 08:00 AM to 04:00 PM
