DIRECTIVES

No.F.2(3)/2025-LGE-B(4):-WHEREAS, the Election Commission of Pakistan, under Article 222(b) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and Sections- 17 and 221 of the Elections Act, 2017 read with Sections-7 and 10 of the Balochistan Local Government Act, 2010, is charged with the duty to delimit the constituencies of the Local Councils in Balochistan Province.

WHEREAS the Election Commission of Pakistan has issued schedule for carrying out delimitation of Urban Union Councils and Wards in Quetta District of Balochistan Province vide Notification No.F.2(3)/2025-LGE-B(1) dated 25.02.2026 whereby, proceedings is going to be started by the Delimitation Committee as per notified timeline.

AND WHEREAS, Delimitation of Urban Union Councils and Wards is required to be carried out giving due regard to the existing boundaries of administrative units and census units such as District, Tehsil, Census Charges, Census Circles etc., tiers and extents of Urban Local Areas. Accordingly any change in composition of these units, tiers and extents of Urban Local Area(s) during on-going delimitation would hamper the smooth proceedings and render the process redundant.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under Article 218(3) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan read with Section-221 of the Elections Act, 2017 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Election Commission of Pakistan is pleased to direct that boundaries of existing administrative units and Urban Local Areas shall stand freezed forthwith and no change in the boundaries of aforementioned administrative units, tiers and extents of Urban Local Area(s) shall be made till the culmination of delimitation of Local Councils in Quetta District of Balochistan Province.
