NOTIFICATION

Islamabad, the 20th January, 2023

No.F.2 (15)/2022-LGE-B-Vol-I.- Whereas, Election Commission had issued schedule for conduct of election to the reserved seats in 32 districts of Balochistan and polling was held on 14-12-2022.

And whereas, various seats remained vacant due to equality of votes among more than two candidates and under sub rule (6) of rule 42 of the Balochistan Local government (Elections) Rule 2013, fresh election program is required to be issued by the Commission.

Now therefore, In exercise of the powers conferred upon it under Article 140(A) and 219(d) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Section 219 of the Elections Act, 2017, Section 16 (1) of Balochistan Local Government Act-2010 read with Rule-48(a) of the Balochistan Local Government (Election) Rules, 2013 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Election Commission of Pakistan hereby calls upon the Members of the Local Councils (Union Councils and Urban Local Councils) where the seat remained vacant of **District, Pishin, Chaman, Nushki, Kharan, Sherani, Killa Saifullah, Barkhan, Musakhail, Sibi, Harnai, Ziarat, Kohlu, Dera Bugti, Nasirabad, Jaffarabad, Sohbatpur, Kachhi, Kalat, Khuzdar, Surab, Matung & Kech** of Balochistan Province to elect the **Members of reserved seats of special interest group as per detail attached at annexure A**, and in connection therewith appoints the following dates of various activities of elections:-

2. To ensure that elections to the Local Government are conducted honestly, justly, fairly in accordance with law and to ensure that the corrupt practices are guarded against, the Election Commission of Pakistan directs that:-

- i. If any person in Government Service misuses his official position in any manner in order to influence results of the elections, he shall be liable to be proceeded against under the Law;
- ii. After issuance of election schedule, no transfer/posting of the Officers and Officials appointed in connection with election shall made without prior approval of the Commission till the publication of election results;
- iii. After the issuance of Election Schedule, the President, Prime Minister, Chief Minister, Governor, Speaker and Deputy Speaker of any assembly, Chairman and Deputy Chairman, of Senate, Federal and Provincial Ministers, Advisors to the Prime Minister or Chief Minister or any other holder of public office shall not visit the area of any local council to announce any development scheme or to canvass or campaign for any candidate or any political party. However, the parliamentarians i.e. members national assembly, provincial assemblies, senate and local government are allowed to participate in the election campaign. They will strictly abide by the code of conduct, directions, instructions and regulations issued by the election commission of Pakistan and violations thereof shall entail legal consequences including contempt proceedings as contemplated in Section 10 of the Elections Act, 2017. In case of public office holder, if someone is resident of the district where election are being held he may visit the district however shall not take part in any kind of political activity.
- iv. No leave of the Government Officers and Officials including Autonomous Bodies/ Authorities will be granted after the issuance of Election Schedule of the Local Government Elections without prior approval of the Commission till the publication of election results. In case leave has already been sanctioned, the officer will not relinquish his charge without approval of the Hon'ble Commission;



- v. Any holder of public office, who is found to have violated any provision of Election Laws or the instructions issued by the Election Commission, shall be proceeded against as mandated in law;
- vi. The DROs, ROs appointed vide this Commission's Notification No.F.2 (2)/2022-LGE-B, dated 22-07-2022 shall perform their duty for the conduct of above elections.

Note:-

- i. The offices of the Election Commission as well as the offices of concerned District election Commissioners, Regional; election Commissioners, as well as District Returning Officer and Returning Officer shall remain open on all public holidays if any activity provided in the schedule falls on that day.
- ii. All electoral activities mentioned in the aforesaid schedule shall be undertaken during office hours and the said timing will also be followed on public holidays fixed for any electoral activity of the schedule.
- iii. Polling Hours will be observed from **08:00 AM to 05:00 PM**.
